The President today announced the appointment of four persons as members of the Committee for Purchase from the Blind and Other Severely Handicapped. They are:

Earl T. O'Loughlin, Brigadier General, USAF, Deputy Director of Maintenance, Engineering and Supply, Deputy Chief of Staff for Systems and Logistics, Headquarters, United States Air Force, representing the Department of the Air Force. He succeeds John Kunsemiller who has resigned.

Wallace H. Robinson, Jr., Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, representing the General Services Administration. He succeeds Michael J. Timbers, who has resigned.

Porter T. Walton, Executive Director, Procurement and Production, Defense Supply Agency, representing the Department of Defense. He succeeds Wallace H. Robinson, Jr., who has resigned.

Joyce C. Young, of Dayton, Ohio, Member of the Board, Goodwill Industries of Dayton, Ohio; Member of the Board, United Way of Dayton, Ohio; and Member, Mental Health and Retardation Board of Montgomery County, Ohio.

The Committee was established to direct procurement of selected commodities and services of the Federal government to qualified non-profit agencies serving blind and other severely handicapped individuals with the objective of increasing employment opportunities for these individuals.
