NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Carl P. Croasdale, of Whitestone, Virginia, to be a member of the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin. He succeeds Arnold C. Sternberg who resigned effective September 17, 1975.

Mr. Croasdale is the owner and operator of C. P. Croasdale Seafood Company in Whitestone.

The President may appoint three members in addition to three members chosen in a manner and for terms provided by the law from the States of Maryland, West Virginia, and from the Commonwealth of Virginia, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the District of Columbia.

The Chairman is appointed by the Commission.
