SUMMARY SCHEDULE

Friday, October 15

The President will depart mid-morning for Des Moines, Iowa. On arrival there, he will travel by car to Ames and at noon address the students, faculty and guests of Iowa State University. Following his address, the President will proceed on a tour of the campus veterinarian facility and then travel to Boone County to have lunch with area farmers, view their harvesting operation, and meet with various farmers.

at 6:00 p.m. the President will depart for O'Hare International Airport in Chicago and then motorcade to Joliet where he will overnight at the Joliet Sheraton. Press plane check-in and departure times will be posted.

Saturday, October 16

The President will board the "Honest Abe" train in Joliet and travel to the St. Louis area. The train is actually called the Abraham Lincoln.

1:00 p.m. - Lincoln (the President will have lunch and filing time for the Press)

3:00 p.m. - Springfield

4:15 p.m. - Carlinville

5:30 p.m. - Alton, Illinois (The "Honest Abe" will terminate in Alton, Ill)

The President will then motorcade to Lambert Field in St. Louis, Missouri where at 7:00 p.m. the President will hold a public rally at the airport.

At approximately 8:00 p.m. the President will depart for Washington, D. C.
