## SUMMARY SCHEDULE

The President will travel to New York and New Jersey on October 12, and 13, overnighing at the New York Hilton on the 12th.

Tuesday, October 12, 1976

The President will depart Washington late morning, at approximately 11:10 a.m. This means the press plane will depart at 10:15 a.m. with press check-in at 9:30 a.m. at Andrews Air Force Base.

Upon arrival at JFK Airport in New York, the President will travel by motorcade and have a public appearance, followed by a meeting with area Jewish leaders at the Yeshiva of Flatbush High School (this is a center for Jewish studies). Following his remarks, there will be a meeting with Jewish leaders there.

- 1:45 p.m. The President will arrive at Borough Park.  
 2:00 p.m. The President will arrive at Bay Ridge.  
 These are areas of Brooklyn, New York, and the President will have brief remarks.
- 5:00 p.m. The President will participate in a meeting with New York State Editors and Publishers at the New York Hilton
- 6:30 p.m. The President will attend a reception prior to the "Salute to the President" dinner. The Vice President will also attend this reception and dinner at the New York Hilton.

Wednesday, October 13, 1976

- 9:30 a.m. The President will travel to Yonkers, where on the City Hall steps there will be a public appearance and brief remarks as he signs the General Revenue Sharing legislation.
- 11:00 a.m. The President will have a public appearance and brief remarks at the White Plains City Hall.
- 12:00 The President will have lunch at the Rockland County Court House in New City, New York.

Wednesday, October 13, 1976 (continued)

- 2:15 p.m. The President will travel by motorcade to the Garden State Plaza in Paramus, New Jersey (Bergen County) for a public appearance and brief remarks.
- 4:30 p.m. The President will arrive for a public rally at the Town and Campus, Union, New Jersey for brief remarks. This will be followed by an area PFC reception.
- 6:00 p.m. Approximate departure time from the Newark Airport for the President.
