11:15 a.m. cdt THE PRESIDENT departs Pontiac en route Bloomington, Illinois.

12:05 p.m. cdt THE PRESIDENT arrives Bloomington, Illinois.
12:40 p.m. cdt THE PRESIDENT departs Bloomington en route Lincoln, Illinois.

1:20 p.m. cdt THE PRESIDENT arrives Lincoln, Illinois. This is a luncheon stop and the President will proceed to Hotel Lincoln for lunch.
