NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed H. R. 12927--Phil M. Landrum Federal Building and Post Office, providing for the naming of a Federal building and post office in Jasper, Georgia, the "Phil M. Landrum Federal Building and Post Office."

The President has signed H. R. 12707--Relief of Barry Ray Leftwich Dibling to make the alien illegitimate son of a U. S. citizen eligible for preferential treatment under immigration law.

The President has signed H. R. 9543--Relief of Eupert Anthony Grant which authorizes issuance of an immigrant visa to the adopted alien son of a permanent resident alien of the United States.

The President has signed H. R. 8027--For the relief of Commander Stanley W. Birch, Junior, relieving him of liability to the United States in the amount of \$1,513.69, representing overpayments of active duty compensation resulting from an administrative error in the determination of his pay entry base date.

The President has signed S. J. Res. 209--Native American Awareness Week which authorizes and requests the President to proclaim the week of October 16, 1976, as "Native American Awareness Week."

The President has signed S. J. Res. 126--Extension of the Interstate Compact to Conserve Oil and Gas, which grants congressional consent, as required by the Constitution of the United States, to extend the Interstate Compact to Conserve Oil and Gas between 29 oil and gas producing States and six associate member States.
