NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed S. 726 -- Land conveyance, Idaho which directs the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain lands to Valley County, Idaho upon payment by the county of the land's fair market value.

The President has signed H.R. 14470 -- Relief of Raul Eduardo Ringle to facilitate issuance of an immigrant visa to the adopted alien child of U.S. citizens.

The President has signed H.R. 13417 -- Relief of Dae Ho Park and Maria Park to facilitate issuance of immigrant visas to two alien children who will be adopted by U.S. citizens.

The President has signed H.J. Res. 1118 -- Black Lung hearing officers which authorizes the Secretary of Labor to appoint qualified individuals to hear and determine benefit claims in black lung cases.

The President has signed H.R. 15136 -- Supplemental military construction authorization for facilities in Guam authorizing \$114,312,000 for military construction and family housing in Guam.

The President has signed S. 999 -- which provides for naming a Federal building after former Senator J. Allen Frear.

The President has signed H.R. 11303 -- Herman T. Schneebeli Federal Building provides for naming a Federal building for retiring Congressman Herman T. Schneebeli.

The President has signed S. 3682 -- Relief of Dr. Oscar J. Briseno; S. 3683 -- Relief of Dr. Juan Bautista Lopez Ruiz to grant permanent residence to two alien physicians who entered the United States on temporary visas for the furtherance of their medical training.

The President has signed H.R. 14956 -- which provides for naming a post office and Federal building in Smithville, Tennessee, the "Joe L. Evins Post Office and Federal Building".
