NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The following information was signed by the President this morning en route to Seattle, Washington. The material was released by the White House Press Office in Washington at 5:30 p.m., EDT:

- 1) Proclamation designating the week of November 21, 1976 as National Family Week.
- 2) Proclamation designating the period of November 19 through November 25, 1976 as National Farm-City Week, 1976.
- 3) Proclamation designating the day of November 25 as a day of National Thanksgiving.
- 4) Proclamation on American Education Week, 1976 beginning November 14, 1976.
- 5) Executive Order -- Amending Executive Order 11021 of May 7, 1962, regarding the authority of the Secretary of the Treasury with respect to the Northern Mariana Islands.
- 6) Executive Order - Physical Fitness and Sports - amending the functions of the Secretary of HEW in developing and coordinating a national program for physical fitness and sports.
- 7) Executive Order - Amends Executive Order No. 11183 to more comprehensively exclude from the White House Fellows Program all non-military personnel currently employed in the Federal Service.
- 8) Proclamation designating December 17, 1976, as Wright Brothers Day, 1976.
