NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of William E. Simon, Secretary of the Treasury, to be United States Governor of the African Development Fund. This position was created by Public Law 94-302 of May 31, 1976, which authorized the President to accept participation for the United States in the African Development Fund. This is a recess appointment.

Secretary Simon was appointed as Secretary of the Treasury on May 7, 1974.

The President today announced the appointment of William D. Rogers, Under Secretary of State for Economic Affairs, to be Alternate Governor of the African Development Fund. This position was also created by Public Law 94-302 of May 31, 1976, which authorized the President to accept participation for the U.S. in the African Development Fund. This is a recess appointment.

Mr. Rogers was appointed Under Secretary of State for Economic Affairs on June 6, 1976.
