Charles Huggins, of Illinois, will succeed Bernice M. Hetzner, whose term has expired.

For a term expiring August 3, 1980

Clara M. Ambrus, of New York, will succeed Ethel Weinberg, whose term has expired.

John A. Hill, of Connecticut, will succeed William N. Hubbard, Jr. whose term has expired.

The aforementioned persons were nominated by the President on October 1, 1976 but were not confirmed prior to adjournment.
