NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced Paul Henry O'Neill, of Fairfax, Virginia, as a member of the President's Committee on Science and Technology. This is a new position.

Mr. O'Neill is Deputy Director of the Office of Management and Budget.

The President today announced the appointment of Jansen Noyes, Jr., of Darien, Connecticut, as a member of the Committee for Purchase of Products and Services of the Blind and Other Severely Handicapped for a term expiring December 21, 1981. This is a reappointment.

Mr. Noyes is Chairman of the Board of Hornblower and Weeks-Hemphill, Noyes, Incorporated, New York, New York.
