1. WE OF COURSE AGREE WITH YOUR REACTION TO FRENCH
AMBASSADOR'S "PERSONAL" PROPOSAL FOR SPECIAL CONSULTATIVE
ARRANGEMENT AND PRECISELY FOR THAT REASON REFRAINED FROM
REACTING OURSELVES WHEN AMBASSADOR MENTIONED IT. SINCE
AMBASSADOR PLANS TO CALL ON US ONCE MORE LATER THIS WEEK
BEFORE HE RETURNS TO PARIS YOU MAY WANT US TO FIND A WAY
TO POUR COLD WATER ON "HIS" IDEA SO THAT PRESIDENT WILL
NOT BE CONFRONTED WITH TURNING DOWN SUCH A PROPOSAL IN
MARTINIQUE.

2. ONE WAY TO DO IT WOULD BE TO SAY THAT WE HOPE ONE
RESULT OF MARTINIQUE WILL BE TO IMPROVE US-FRENCH
COMMUNICATION AT VARIOUS LEVELS ON ISSUES OF MUTUAL

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INTEREST BOTH BILATERALLY AND IN EXISTING MULTILATERAL INSTITUTIONS.

3. WE COULD ADD THAT WHILE WELCOMING IMPROVED OVERALL COMMUNICATION, ESPECIALLY IN ORDER TO AVOID SURPRISE MOVES IN FUTURE, WE WOULD HESITATE TO ESTABLISH SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS IN ANY ONE FIELD, PARTICULARLY WHERE ADEQUATE MECHANISMS ALREADY EXIST AND MERELY AWAIT TO BE USED MORE EFFECTIVELY.

4. UNLESS YOU WANT US TO WE WOULD NOT TAKE INITIATIVE WITH AMBASSADOR ALONG ABOVE LINES BUT WOULD DO SO ONLY IF HE RAISES THE MATTER AGAIN WHEN HE SEES US. INGERSOLL

SUBJECT: LETTER FROM THE SECRETARY ON KHMER REPRESENTATION

1. DESPITE EARLIER ASSURANCE TO THE GKR'S SUPPORTERS, PARTICULARLY JAPAN, THAT PERU WOULD ABSTAIN ON THE ASEAN KHMER RESOLUTION, THE PERUVIANS HAVE NOW RETREATED FROM THIS POSITION AND STATED THAT THEY WILL OPPOSE THE FRIENDLY RESOLUTION AND PRIORITY IN ORDER TO KEEP THEIR THIRD WORLD/NON ALIGNED STATUS INTACT. WHILE ADMITTEDLY THERE IS SMALL CHANCE OF SUCCESS, A DIRECT REQUEST FROM YOU COULD PERHAPS PERSUADE THE GAP TO ABSTAIN ON PRIORITY. (WE ARE PLEASED TO NOTE THAT YOUR REQUEST TO PRESIDENT RONGO OF GABON IN THIS VEIN WAS SUCCESSFUL.) IF YOU CONCUR THAT THE MESSAGE THAT FOLLOWS SHOULD BE DELIVERED TO FOREIGN MINISTER DE LA FLOR, PLEASE TRANSMIT THE APPROVAL MESSAGE DIRECTLY TO LIMA.

2. BEGIN QUOTE: DEAR MIGUEL ANGEL: I REGRET THAT OUR



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MEETING IN NEW YORK IN SEPTEMBER WAS TOO SHORT TO DISCUSS ALL OF THE ISSUES OF MUTUAL CONCERN TO US. I AM THEREFORE TAKING THIS MEANS OF BRINGING TO YOUR ATTENTION A MATTER TO WHICH I ATTACH THE GREATEST IMPORTANCE AND ON WHICH I EARNESTLY SEEK YOUR GOVERNMENT'S SUPPORT. I REFER TO THE PROBLEM OF CAMBODIA AND, MORE PARTICULARLY, TO THE DEBATE ON THE ISSUE OF CAMBODIAN REPRESENTATION WHICH HAS BEGUN IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

WE BELIEVE THAT WAR IN INDOCHINA IN GENERAL AND CAMBODIA IN PARTICULAR HAS GONE ON TOO LONG AND COST TOO MUCH IN TERMS OF HUMAN LIVES AND RESOURCES AND IN TERMS OF DISTRACTING ATTENTION FROM MORE POSITIVE ENDEAVORS. WE BELIEVE THAT A PEACEFUL SOLUTION TO THE WAR IN CAMBODIA IS AN URGENT NECESSITY. WE STAND READY TO HELP IN ACHIEVING SUCH A SOLUTION. THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KHMER REPUBLIC, FOR ITS PART, HAS OFFERED NEGOTIATIONS WITHOUT PRECONDITIONS AND I HOPE THAT ALL PEACELOVING NATIONS WOULD SUPPORT THE PRINCIPLE OF NEGOTIATIONS EVEN THOUGH THERE MAY NOT BE AGREEMENT ON THE MERITS OF THE RESPECTIVE CAUSES. UNFORTUNATELY, THE NOMINAL LEADER OF THE COMMUNIST INSURGENTS, PRINCE SIHANOUK, HAS REJECTED NEGOTIATIONS, BELIEVING THAT A MILITARY VICTORY CAN BE ACHIEVED.

MY GOVERNMENT BELIEVES THAT THE INSURGENTS CANNOT WIN MILITARILY. IT IS ALSO EVIDENT THAT THE GOVERNMENT CANNOT DEFEAT THE INSURGENTS AND THE COUNTRY APPEARS DESTINED FOR ENDLESS WAR UNLESS GREATER MORAL AUTHORITY IS BROUGHT TO BEAR ON THE PARTIES.

AS YOU KNOW, THE ASIAN NEIGHBORS OF CAMBODIA HAVE JOINED TOGETHER TO DRAFT AND SPONSOR A RESOLUTION IN THE UNITED NATIONS WHICH WOULD ENCOURAGE THE UN TO ENGAGE ITSELF IN THIS ENDEAVOR. WE SUPPORT THIS AND BELIEVE IT IS A MOST APPROPRIATE ACTIVITY FOR THE ORGANIZATION. WE DO NOT BELIEVE, AND HOPE THAT YOU AGREE, THAT THE UN SHOULD ATTEMPT TO PREJUDGE THE ISSUE BY TAKING UPON ITSELF THE RESPONSIBILITY TO CHANGE THE REPRESENTATION OF THE CAMBODIAN PEOPLE AS PROPOSED BY ONE RESOLUTION NOW BEFORE THE ASSEMBLY. THIS WOULD NOT ONLY DO GREAT DAMAGE TO



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THE BASIC UN PRECEPT OF SELF-DETERMINATION BUT WOULD CONSTITUTE A VERY DANGEROUS PRECEDENT FOR ALL MEMBER STATES. WE BELIEVE THAT SUCH AN ACTION TO SEAT AN EXILE REGIME COULD ALSO WELL MAKE IT MORE DIFFICULT TO BEGIN NEGOTIATIONS, THEREBY PROLONGING THE SUFFERING OF THE CAMBODIAN PEOPLE.

IT IS WITH THESE THOUGHTS IN MIND, THEREFORE, THAT I ASK YOUR SUPPORT FOR THE RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY THE ASIAN COUNTRIES AND VOTING PRIORITY FOR IT. BEST REGARDS,

TO ATTEMPT TO CONVINCE FRASER AND ABOUT TWENTY OTHERS WHOM
HE INFLUENCES TO VOTE FOR THE FOREIGN ASSISTANCE ACT.
WE CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT A MEETING WITH FRASER ET. AL. WILL
ACHIEVE THIS PURPOSE; WE CAN GUARANTEE THAT WITHOUT THIS
MEETING FRASER AND THE TWENTY VOTES WILL GO AGAINST THE
BILL. IN ADDITION FRASER WILL PROBABLY STATE ON THE
FLOOR OF THE HOUSE THAT HIS OPPOSITION IS AT LEAST IN
PART ENGENDERED BY YOUR UNWILLINGNESS TO FACE HIM ON THE

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ISSUE OF HUMAN RIGHTS.

3. THOSE WHO WOULD ACCOMPANY FRASER:

THE OTHER CONGRESSMEN THAT HE HAS SUGGESTED FOR THE MEETING

ARE: JONATHAN BINGHAM, LEE HAMILTON, THOMAS (TIP) O'NEILL, LLOYD MEEDS, PATSY MINK, CHARLES WHALEN, AND MORRIS UDALL.

THESE ARE ALL LIBERAL BUT RATIONAL PEOPLE. WE CAN BE RELATIVELY CERTAIN THAT MOST WOULD LISTEN TO YOU WITH AN OPEN MIND AND PROBABLY ARE CONVINCIBLE. MOST, WE BELIEVE, WOULD NOT TAKE THEIR DISAGREEMENTS, SHOULD THERE BE ANY, TO THE PRESS.

4. SUBSTANCE OF THE MEETING:

WE DO NOT CONTEMPLATE NOR WOULD WE ADVISE THAT YOU NEGOTIATE WITH FRASER AND COMPANY. INSTEAD WE WOULD EXPECT YOU TO DESCRIBE THIS ADMINISTRATION'S VIEW OF HOW TO HANDLE THE ISSUE OF HUMAN RIGHTS INTERNATIONALLY. WE BELIEVE YOU SHOULD EXPLAIN THE NECESSITY TO SEEK THE ATTAINABLE AND POINT OUT THAT THE BEST WAY TO ASSURE HUMAN RIGHTS IS TO MAINTAIN OUR LEVERAGE AND BE PERSUASIVE -- NOT BY STRONG ARM TACTICS.

WE CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT THERE WILL NOT BE DEBATE IN THE MEETING; IT IS PROBABLE THAT THERE WILL BE. IT IS EQUALLY PROBABLE THAT NO MATTER HOW HARD YOU GO AT YOUR AUDIENCE ON THE GENERAL VIEW OF HOW TO HANDLE HUMAN RIGHTS PROBLEMS, YOU WILL BE FACED WITH SPECIFIC QUESTIONS ON WHY WE SHOULD PROVIDE MILITARY ASSISTANCE TO REPRESSIVE REGIMES IN CHILE, KOREA, ETHIOPIA, ETC.

5. THE DANGERS:

WE CAN OFFER NO GUARANTEE THAT FRASER AND PERHAPS (BUT LESS LIKELY) OTHERS IN HIS GROUP WOULD MAKE A PUBLIC STATEMENT AFTER THE MEETING THAT YOUR RESPONSE HAD BEEN UNSATISFACTORY. FRASER AT LEAST MAY WELL DO SO.





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ONE POSSIBLE PLOY YOU MIGHT WANT TO CONSIDER USING IN AN ATTEMPT TO HEAD THIS OFF WOULD BE TO SHOW FRASER THE STATEMENT OF POLICY ON HUMAN RIGHTS THAT WE HAVE HAD UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR SOME TIME AND LET HIM ANNOUNCE AT THE CLOSE OF THE MEETING THAT YOU AND HE HAD DISCUSSED IT AND JOINTLY AGREED UPON ITS RELEASE AS A STATEMENT OF POLICY. THIS MIGHT WORK BUT THERE IS NO QUESTION THAT IT PUTS YOU IN A POSITION OF APPARENTLY HAVING RESPONDED TO FRASER'S PRESSURES.

ALTERNATIVELY, SHOULD YOU AGREE TO MEET WITH FRASER BUT FEEL YOU DO NOT WANT TO USE THE TACTICS SUGGESTED IN THE

PARAGRAPH ABOVE, YOU MAY WANT TO STRENGTHEN YOUR HAND BY ISSUING THE POLICY STATEMENT BEFORE THE MEETING AND SHOWING IT TO FRASER WHEN HE MEETS WITH YOU.

6. IN SUM:

WE ARE ASKING YOU (AND REGRETTABLY NO ONE ELSE BUT YOU CAN DO THE JOB) TO TAKE A CHANCE THAT YOU COULD CONVINCE FRASER OR AT LEAST MOST OF HIS COLLEAGUES TO SUPPORT THE FOREIGN ASSISTANCE BILL WITHOUT AN EXTREME CHALLENGE ON THE ISSUE OF HUMAN RIGHTS. WE COUNTERPOSE THIS UNCERTAINTY AGAINST THE CERTAINTY THAT WITHOUT THIS ACTION WE WILL LOSE SOME TWENTY VOTES ON A BILL WHICH IS ALREADY IN TROUBLE. IN ALL FRANKNESS WE DO NOT KNOW WHERE IN THIS CONGRESS WE WILL FIND THE VOTES TO CARRY THE BILL THROUGH SHORT OF THE TWENTY VOTES HERE INVOLVED.

7. RECOMMENDATION:

THAT YOU PERMIT US TO SCHEDULE A MEETING WITH CONGRESSMAN FRASER AND THOSE OTHER CONGRESSMEN HE HAS SUGGESTED. INGERSOLL

1. WHEN PERLE CALLED ME TODAY ON THE EAST EUROPEAN PROBLEM IN THE TRADE BILL (REPORTED SEPARATELY IN MY ACTIVITIES REPORT) HE LAUNCHED INTO A TIRADE ON THE SALT AGREEMENT. HE SAID SCOOP WAS "STUNNED" BY WHAT BRENT HAD TOLD HIM. HE WOULD FIGHT IT ALL THE WAY. IT WAS INCOMPREHENSIBLE HOW WE COULD HAVE RUSHED INTO AN AGREEMENT THAT MADE NO COMPENSATION FOR THROWWEIGHT AND IN THAT RESPECT WAS WORSE THAN WHAT HAD BEEN OFFERED TO NIXON IN JULY. SCOOP SUPPOSEDLY COULD NOT UNDERSTAND HOW THERE COULD BE AN ARMS CONTROL AGREEMENT THAT REQUIRED US TO BUILD UP THROWWEIGHT IF WE WANTED TO BE MORE NEARLY EQUAL TO THE SOVIETS RATHER THAN REQUIRING THEM TO REDUCE. PERLE SAID GETTING RID OF FBS WAS FINE BUT BY NOT HOLDING OUT FOR MORE WE HAD COME UP WITH A BAD AGREEMENT. IT WOULD ALL COME OUT IN THE HEARINGS.

2. I DID NOT WISH TO GET DRAWN INTO A DEBATE AND MERELY

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SAID I WAS TOUCHED BY HIS CONCERN WITH ARMS CONTROL. HE IMMEDIATELY SAID HIS CONCERN WAS WITH THE U.S. STRATEGIC POSTURE IN 1985. I SAID IN THAT CASE WE WERE WELL PROTECTED BY WHAT HAD BEEN AGREED. I SAID THAT I WOULD HAVE THOUGHT THEY WOULD BE PLEASED SINCE THE REQUIREMENT

3. IT IS DIFFICULT TO TELL HOW MUCH OF THIS IS PERLE AND HOW MUCH JACKSON. ON PAST FORM, HOWEVER, SCOOP WILL SOONER OR LATER PICK UP PERLE'S VIEWS.

4. I DO NOT OF COURSE KNOW ALL THE CONSIDERATIONS IN THE PRESIDENT'S AND YOUR MIND, BUT IT SEEMS TO ME AT LEAST DESIRABLE TO UNLEASH SCHLESINGER AND BROWN, WHO I GATHER ARE VERY PLEASED WITH VLADIVOSTOK. THAT WAY AT LEAST JACKSON WILL HAVE TO DEBATE THE ADMINISTRATION AS A WHOLE. SCHLESINGER WILL IN ANY EVENT COMMENT SOONER OR LATER WHEN HE HAS A PRESS CONFERENCE OR SOME OTHER APPEARANCE. I WOULD THINK THAT THE RISK THAT HE WOULD MAKE THE "TOUGHNESS PAYS OFF" ARGUMENT COULD BE ELIMINATED BY GIVING HIM FIRM PRESIDENTIAL GUIDANCE AND IMPRESSING ON HIM THAT THE FOLLOW-ON NEGOTIATIONS WILL BE JEOPARDIZED IF BREZHNEV IS MADE TO LOOK AS IF HE BACKED DOWN.

DEAR MIGUEL ANGEL:

REPORTS HAVE REACHED ME RECENTLY OF DISTURBING PRESS
STORIES AND RUMORS IN PERU ALLEGING THAT THE UNITED STATES
IS CARRYING OUT INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES IN YOUR COUNTRY
DESIGNED TO WEAKEN THE REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT. AS YOU

KNOW, I PLACE THE VERY HIGHEST VALUE ON THE GOOD RELATIONS
BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES -- AND ON OUR OWN PERSONAL
FRIENDSHIP. IT WOULD BE OF GRAVE CONCERN TO ME IF SUCH
CHARGES WERE TO GAIN CREDENCE AMONG RESPONSIBLE PERUVIANS.

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TO PUT THE MATTER AT REST I WANT TO ASSURE YOU WITHOUT QUALIFICATION THAT THESE ALLEGATIONS HAVE NO FOUNDATION IN FACT AND THAT NO SUCH ACTIVITIES ARE BEING CARRIED OUT. MY GOVERNMENT MAINTAINS ABSOLUTE RESPECT FOR PERU'S SOVEREIGNTY, A RESPECT WHICH ALL OF ITS AGENCIES ARE UNDER THE STRICTEST INSTRUCTIONS TO OBSERVE.

I HAVE ASKED ASSISTANT SECRETARY ROGERS WHEN HE VISITS PERU FOR THE AYACUCHO CELEBRATIONS TO MAKE CERTAIN THAT ANY MISUNDERSTANDINGS YOU OR YOUR COLLEAGUES MIGHT HAVE ON THIS POINT ARE COMPLETELY CLARIFIED. 1. FOR YOUR BACKGROUND: ISRAELIS RAISED WITH US LAST WEEK THEIR CONCERN ABOUT SYRIAN INTENTION TO DESTROY BUNKERS IN FORMER ISRAELI POSITIONS ON GOLAN HEIGHTS. WE CHECKED WITH DEPUTY SYG URQUHART AND CONFIRMED ISRAELIS RECENTLY HAD OBJECTED TO UN-SYRIAN PROPOSAL FOR DESTRUCTION OF BUNKERS, ALTHOUGH THEY HAD KNOWN ABOUT IT FOR SOME TIME. URQUHART SAID



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HE THOUGHT SYRIANS COULD BE HELD OFF TO END OF THIS WEEK IN LIGHT OF IMMINENT UNDOF RENEWAL. BUT LATER ADVISED HE HAD NOT KNOWN AT THE TIME THAT SYRIANS HAD IN FACT ALREADY GONE AHEAD WITH THE BUNKER DESTRUCTION.

2. DINITZ HAS GIVEN ME TEXT OF MESSAGE FROM ALLON TO WALDHEIM OF NOVEMBER 25 ON THIS SUBJECT. HE DID NOT REQUEST ANY US ACTION AND OBSERVED IT WAS MATTER FOR ISRAEL TO HANDLE WITH UN. BUFFUM, ATHERTON AND I ALL AGREE WE SHOULD STAY OUT OF THIS ONE AND LEAVE IT IN UN CHANNELS, BUT I WANT YOU TO BE AWARE OF PROBLEM. TEXT OF ALLON MESSAGE TO WALDHEIM FOLLOWS.

3. BEGIN TEXT:

A. LAST NIGHT AND DURING THIS MORNING ISRAELI FORCES ON THE CEASEFIRE LINE NOTICED UNUSUAL SYRIAN ACTIVITY AT FORMER ISRAELI POSITIONS 60 AND 70.

B. OUR LIAISON OFFICER TO THE UNITED NATIONS FORCES SENT SEVERAL MESSAGES TO UNDOF HEADQUARTERS, STARTING FROM 1200 HOURS TODAY, INQUIRING AS TO THE NATURE OF THIS SYRIAN ACTIVITY. FURTHER MESSAGES WERE SENT AFTER 1630 HOURS WHEN IT WAS SEEN THAT PART OF THE POSITIONS HAD BEEN DESTROYED.

C. NO SATISFACTORY REPLY TO THESE MESSAGES WAS GIVEN UNTIL GENERAL SITLASVUO'S MESSAGE REPORTING THAT THE TWO POSITIONS HAD BEEN DESTROYED BY THE SYRIANS, WAS RECEIVED AT 2000 HOURS.

D. YOU ARE OF COURSE AWARE OF THE UNDERTAKING INCORPORATED IN THE AGREED STATEMENT MADE BY GENERAL SITLASVUO ON 5 JUNE 1974 AS CHAIRMAN OF THE ISRAEL-SYRIA DISENGAGEMENT TALKS IN GENEVA, TO THE EFFECT THAT UNDOF WILL ASSUME CONTROL, WILL ESTABLISH AND MAN OBSERVATION POSTS IN THE EVACUATED ISRAEL POSITIONS. ISRAEL EVACUATED THESE POSITIONS ON THE STRENGTH OF THIS UNDERTAKING WHICH, WITH THE REST OF THE CHAIRMAN'S AGREED STATEMENT, IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE DISENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT.



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E. THE DESTRUCTION OF THESE TWO POSITIONS BY THE SYRIANS IS THUS IN BREACH BOTH OF THE AGREEMENT AND OF YOUR OWN ASSURANCE TO AMBASSADOR TEKOAH THAT NO ACTION WOULD BE TAKEN AS LONG AS YOU HAD NOT DISCUSSED THE MATTER WITH US IN JERUSALEM.

F. I MUST EXPRESS OUR STRONG PROTEST AT THIS UNILATERAL SYRIAN BREACH OF THE AGREEMENT AND AT UNDOUBT EVIDENT INABILITY TO PREVENT IT. THESE ARE MATTERS OF GRAVE CONCERN.

G. I URGE YOU TO ENSURE THAT ALL SYRIAN ACTIVITY AT THESE POSITIONS CEASES FORTHWITH AND THAT SUCH UNILATERAL ACTION IS NOT UNDERTAKEN IN THE FUTURE.

H. I LOOK FORWARD TO SEEING YOU AND YOUR PARTY TOMORROW. KINDEST PERSONAL REGARDS, YIGAL ALLON. END TEXT. INGERSOLL

2. BEGIN TEXT: DEAR MR. SECRETARY OF STATE: THANK YOU
FOR THE MESSAGE WHICH YOU SENT ME IN TOKYO, TO WHICH IT
WAS PHYSICALLY IMPOSSIBLE TO REPLY DURING MY VERY BRIEF
STAY IN JAPAN.

3. THE ENERGY PROBLEM ALSO TOOK AN IMPORTANT PLACE IN MY
TALKS WITH MR. KIMURA. WE FOUND THAT THERE WAS NOT NECES-
SARILY CONTRADICTION BETWEEN THE VIEWS OF THE US GOVERN-
MENT AND THE POSITION OF THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT. WE ALL,
IT SEEMS TO ME, ARE CONVINCED THAT SOLUTION OF THE ENERGY
PROBLEM WILL COME ABOUT THROUGH INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION
WHICH SHOULD BE APPLIED ON TWO LEVELS, THAT OF COHESION TO
BE ESTABLISHED BY THE CONSUMERS, ESPECIALLY BETWEEN IN-
DUSTRIALIZED COUNTRIES, AND THAT OF THE NECESSARY DIALOGUE
BETWEEN PRODUCERS AND CONSUMERS.



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4. NONETHELESS I STRESSED A POINT WITH MY COLLEAGUE THAT I WOULD LIKE TO TAKE UP AGAIN WITH YOU. COOPERATION BETWEEN THE MAJOR ECONOMIC GROUPS IN ORDER TO REDUCE THE

ENERGY DEPENDENCY OF THE US, JAPAN, AND EUROPE IS OBVIOUSLY NECESSARY. IT WAS FRANCE, MOREOVER, WHICH INITIATED THE IDEA OF REDUCTION OF CONSUMPTION BUT, AS YOU KNOW, THIS IS A LONG-TERM PROGRAM AND THE OPENING OF THE PRODUCERS/CONSUMERS DIALOGUE CANNOT BE SUBORDINATED TO COMPLETION OF THAT PROGRAM.

5. ON THE OTHER HAND, IT IS OUT OF THE QUESTION THAT DISCUSSIONS, PROPERLY SPEAKING, BETWEEN PRODUCERS AND CONSUMERS GET UNDER WAY WITHOUT THE CONSUMER COUNTRIES HAVING COORDINATED THE POSITIONS THEY WILL HAVE TO DEFEND. IN OUR VIEW SUCH COORDINATION OUGHT TO TAKE PLACE WITHIN THE OECD. WE HOPE THAT THE NINE WILL SPEAK THERE WITH A SINGLE VOICE BUT IN NO WAY DO WE HAVE ANY REPROACH FOR THE IEA, TO WHOM ACTIVITY WE HAVE PLACED NO OBSTACLE. SUCH COORDINATION IN NO WAY EXCLUDES, IN OUR VIEW, CONVENING A PREPARATORY MEETING AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AT WHICH PRODUCERS AND CONSUMERS WOULD LIMIT THEMSELVES TO WORKING OUT THE AGENDA AND THE MEETING ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE ACTUAL CONFERENCE.

6. OUR OWN THOUGHT IS THAT RAPID ESTABLISHMENT OF A STRUCTURE OF DIALOGUE WOULD BE THE BEST MEANS TO PREVENT UNILATERAL DECISIONS ON THE PART OF THE PRODUCERS. AS A MATTER OF FACT WE ARE ALL THREATENED BY NEW INCREASES.

7. IN SUM, I AM CONVINCED THAT THE COMING FRANCO-AMERICAN MEETINGS WILL DEMONSTRATE THAT OUR RESPECTIVE DECISIONS CAN READILY BE RECONCILED AND I AM DELIGHTED THAT I WILL SOON MEET WITH YOU AT BRUSSELS.

8. PLEASE ACCEPT, DEAR MR. SECRETARY OF STATE, THE ASSURANCES OF MY MOST FRIENDLY REGARDS. JEAN SAUVAGNARGUES.

FOLLOWING ARE THE CONSIDERED VIEWS OF THE NUMEROUS INTERESTED OFFICES AND OFFICERS ON MERITS OF PERCY'S PROPOSALS:

1) RE HIS SUGGESTION THAT SECRETARY URGE RABASA TO GO TO NEW YORK, WE THINK ON BALANCE HIS PRESENCE THERE WOULD BE USEFUL IF HE IS PREPARED EITHER TO PUT SOME MUSCLE BEHIND AN EFFORT TO GET A COMPROMISE RESOLUTION OR TO ENCOURAGE DEFERRAL OF A VOTE UNTIL NEXT YEAR SO THAT MORE NEGOTIATIONS CAN TAKE PLACE. WHETHER HE WOULD DO EITHER OF THESE IS STILL A BIG QUESTION MARK, AND THE ANSWER CAN PROBABLY BEST BE OBTAINED WHEN HE SPEES THE SECRETARY HERE ON DECEMBER 4. EVEN SO, WE THINK IT WOULD BE A REASONABLE RESPONSE TO PERCY'S REQUEST TO BUTTER RABASA UP A BIT BY A LETTER

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FROM THE SECRETARY INDICATING HIS CONTINUING PERSONAL INTEREST IN THIS ISSUE, COUPLED WITH A GENTLE SUGGESTION THAT HIS PRESENCE IN NEW YORK MIGHT HELP THE SITUATION. TEXT OF SUCH A MESSAGE WOULD READ:

QUOTE DEAR EMILIO:

EVEN THOUGH I HAVE BEEN IN THE FAR EAST FOR THE LAST WEEK OR SO AS YOU KNOW, I HAVE BEEN FOLLOWING THE KEY DEVELOPMENTS IN NEW YORK WITH CLOSE PERSONAL ATTENTION. AMONG THESE IS THE CHARTER OF ECONOMIC RIGHTS AND DUTIES. SINCE I KNOW HOW MUCH IMPORTANCE YOU AND YOUR PRESIDENT ATTACH TO IT,

I GATHER THAT THE CHARTER WILL NOT COME TO A VOTE FOR ANOTHER TEN DAYS OR SO. IN ANY EVENT, I HOPE THIS IS THE CASE BECAUSE I WOULD VERY MUCH WELCOME THE OPPORTUNITY TO TALK WITH YOU ABOUT IT AGAIN WHEN WE MEET ON DECEMBER 4. I WILL BE PARTICULARLY INTERESTED IN YOUR REACTION TO THE PRESENT STATE OF PLAY, GIVEN WHAT IS REPORTED TO ME AS INCREASING CONCERN IN NEW YORK ABOUT THE DIVISIVE SITUATION WHICH WOULD BE CREATED BY PROCEEDING TO A VOTE ON A CHARTER WHICH WE AND A NUMBER OF OTHER MEMBERS PROBABLY CANNOT SUPPORT.

FOR OUR PART, WE WOULD BE WILLING TO MAKE A MAJOR LAST-DITCH EFFORT TO GET AN ACCEPTABLE AGREEMENT AT THIS SESSION. I BELIEVE THIS IS POSSIBLE IF THE GROUP OF 77 CAN BE BROUGHT TO DEMONSTRATE THE SAME WILLINGNESS TO COMPROMISE THAT YOU YOURSELF HAVE DISPLAYED. I HAVE BEEN IN TOUCH WITH SENATOR PERCY, WHO IS EAGER TO JOIN IN AN EFFORT TO HEAD OFF THE UNHAPPY CONFRONTATION WHICH IT NOW APPEARS WE ARE HEADING TOWARD. SUCH AN OUTCOME, I THINK YOU WILL AGREE, WOULD DEAL ANOTHER BODY BLOW TO A GENERAL ASSEMBLY SESSION THAT HAS SUFFERED BADLY FROM THE ILLEGAL SUSPENSION OF SOUTH AFRICA AND THE UNWISE RECEPTION OF ARAFAT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE PLO.

SINCE I DO NOT KNOW WHAT YOUR SCHEDULE MAY INVOLVE FOR THE IMMEDIATE FUTURE, IT IS DIFFICULT TO KNOW HOW IT WOULD MAKE MOST SENSE FOR US TO PROCEED. HOWEVER, IF YOU





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SHARP MY CONCERN ABOUT THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE CONFRONTATION WHICH SEEMS TO BE BUILDING. AND HAVE THE TIME AND INCLINATION TO GO TO NEW YORK EITHER BEFORE OR AFTER OUR MEETING ON DECEMBER 4, I WOULD WARMLY WELCOME IT. YOUR PERSONAL LEADERSHIP IN AN EFFORT TO GET A COMPROMISE PROPOSAL WOULD BE A MAJOR STEP IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION.

IN ANY EVENT, I GREATLY LOOK FORWARD TO SEEING YOU NEXT WEEK AND TO DISCUSSING THIS SUBJECT FURTHER.

1. FOLLOWING IS A DRAFT TEXT FOR MESSAGES FROM YOU TO
CALLAGHAN, GENSCHER AND SAUVAGNARGUES, DRAWN FROM YOUR
MESSAGES TO THE SHAH, GIVING THEM A GENERAL RUNDOWN ON
THE EAST AND MIDDLE EAST DISCUSSIONS IN VLADIVOSTOK.
THE MIDDLE EAST PORTIONS ARE MARKED OPTIONAL.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

DEAR BLANK:

I WOULD LIKE TO GIVE YOU AN INITIAL RUNDOWN ON THE
STRATEGIC ARMS (OPTIONAL) AND MIDDLE EAST DISCUSSIONS IN
VLADIVOSTOK.

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AS YOU KNOW, WHILE WE WISH TO REACH A SALT AGREEMENT THAT WILL FURTHER CURB THE STRATEGIC ARMS RACE, WE HAVE NO INTENTION OF TAKING ANY STEPS THAT WOULD WEAKEN WESTERN DEFENSES OR HINDER OUR OVERALL EAST-WEST STRATEGY. I AM PLEASED TO TELL YOU THAT IN THE TALKS BETWEEN PRESIDENT FORD AND GENERAL SECRETARY BREZHNEV WE MADE SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS TOWARD A TEN YEAR FOLLOW-ON AGREEMENT TO SALT I THAT SHOULD BOTH ENHANCE GLOBAL STABILITY AND ASSURE CONTINUED STRONG WESTERN DEFENSES.

THE SOVIET SIDE FIRST PROPOSED THAT IT BE PERMITTED A LARGER NUMBER OF CENTRAL SYSTEMS WHILE WE COULD HAVE A SLIGHTLY LARGER NUMBER OF MIRVED MISSILES. THIS HAS BEEN THE PATTERN IN OUR DISCUSSIONS OVER RECENT MONTHS. WHILE IN PRINCIPLE THERE WERE POSSIBILITIES IN THIS APPROACH IF THE ACTUAL NUMBERS WERE SATISFACTORY, IT MIGHT HAVE HAD SOME PSYCHOLOGICAL DISADVANTAGES IN FORMALIZING A SOVIET EDGE IN NUMBERS OF CENTRAL SYSTEMS -- EVEN THOUGH SUCH AN EDGE WOULD BE MEANINGLESS IN STRATEGIC TERMS. AFTER THE PRESIDENT HELD FIRM, THE SOVIET SIDE CHANGED ITS POSITION TO AGREE TO EQUAL NUMBERS IN CENTRAL

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SYSTEMS AS WELL AS MIRVED MISSILES. IN ADDITION THE SOVIETS DROPPED THEIR INSISTENCE ON INCLUDING OUR FORWARD BASED SYSTEMS IN THE CENTRAL SYSTEMS TOTALS OR ON RECEIVING COMPENSATION FOR OTHER THREATS TO THE USSR. WE REACHED AGREEMENT ON ACTUAL NUMBERS ABOUT WHICH I WILL TALK TO YOU PERSONALLY IN BRUSSELS (WASHINGTON FOR GENSCHER) AS WELL AS THESE BASIC PRINCIPLES. ACCORDINGLY, I THINK WE HAVE OVERCOME THE MAJOR POLITICAL AND CONCEPTUAL PROBLEMS FOR A NEW

SALT AGREEMENT. ALTHOUGH THERE ARE MANY DIFFICULT TECHNICAL PROBLEMS TO WORK OUT, PRIMARILY REGARDING VERIFICATION, THERE IS A VERY GOOD CHANCE THAT WE WILL BE ABLE TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT NEXT SUMMER WHEN GENERAL SECRETARY BREZHNEV VISITS THE UNITED STATES.

I THINK THIS HOPEFUL PROGRESS DEMONSTRATES THE SOVIET NEED TO MAINTAIN THE MOMENTUM OF GOOD RELATIONS WITH US. THE AGREEMENT THAT NOW SEEMS POSSIBLE IS DUE IN PART TO OUR FIRM STANCE IN THE NEGOTIATIONS AND THE CLEAR SIGNALS WE HAVE SENT ON OUR READINESS TO CONTINUE TO DEVELOP OUR DEFENSES IF MOSCOW IS NOT PREPARED TO BE REASONABLE. I THINK THE COURSE WE ARE ON SHOULD BE IN THE INTERESTS OF

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THE WESTERN ALLIANCE AND CONTRIBUTE TO A MORE SECURE WORLD.

BEGIN OPTIONAL SECTION:

WITH REGARD TO THE MIDDLE EAST, THE PRESIDENT, WHILE AGREEING THAT CONTINUED US/SOVIET CONSULTATION AND COOPERATION REMAIN IMPORTANT, STRESSED THE NECESSITY OF CAREFUL PREPARATION FOR ANY FURTHER DIPLOMATIC MOVES. PUBLICLY IN THE COMMUNIQUE, THE PRESIDENT AGREED THAT THE "WORK" OF THE GENEVA CONFERENCE SHOULD RESUME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. IN HIS PRIVATE TALKS, HE EMPHASIZED THE NECESSITY OF LAYING THE GROUNDWORK SYSTEMATICALLY AND CHOOSING CAREFULLY THE APPROPRIATE TIME FOR SUCH A MOVE. THUS, OUR CONSULTATIONS WITH THE NEGOTIATING PARTIES WILL CONTINUE TO FORM THE BASIS OF OUR WORK TOWARD A SETTLEMENT. IN THIS CONNECTION,

I HAVE ASKED FOREIGN MINISTER ALI'ON TO COME TO WASHINGTON SHORTLY AFTER MY RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES IN ORDER TO CONTINUE OUR CONSULTATIONS ON HOW BEST NOW TO PROCEED. THE TALKS IN VLADIVOSTOK IN NO WAY LIMITED OUR ABILITY TO PROMOTE FURTHER PROGRESS. IT IS OUR INTENTION TO

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PURSUe THESE EFFORTS WITH ENERGY AND DEDICATION IN THE WEEKS AHEAD.

YOU WILL NOTICE THAT THE COMMUNIQUE REFLECTS THE CONTINUING AMERICAN CONVICTION THAT THE LEGITIMATE INTERESTS OF THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE MUST BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT IN ANY JUST AND LASTING SOLUTION. AS I HAVE SAID ELSEWHERE, THE QUESTION IS NOT WHETHER LEGITIMATE PALESTINIAN INTERESTS SHOULD BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT IN THE NEGOTIATIONS BUT HOW THIS CAN BE DONE. THIS IS THE ISSUE THAT MUST BE ADDRESSED IN THE MORE DIFFICULT SITUATION CREATED BY THE RABAT CONFERENCE. THE OVER- RIDING CONCERN OF THE UNITED STATES AT THIS POINT IS TO ACHIEVE FURTHER PROGRESS IN THE NEGOTIATIONS ALREADY LAUNCHED SO THAT A NEW SITUATION WILL BE CREATED WHICH MAY MAKE FURTHER STEPS POSSIBLE. IN SHORT, WHILE THE TALKS IN VLADIVOSTOK SIGNIFICANTLY ADVANCED US/SOVIET RELATIONS ON OTHER MATTERS OF GLOBAL IMPORTANCE, THE U.S. REMAINS FREE TO PURSUE THE STRATEGY IN THE MIDDLE EAST WHICH HAS RESULTED IN THE PROGRESS OF THE PAST YEAR.
