SUBJECT: AMBASSADOR GATES! MEETING WITH PREMIER HUA

AS YOU KNOW, IT IS HOPED THAT AMBASSADOR GATES WILL HAVE A SUBSTANTIVE MEETING WITH PREMIER HUA NOT TOO LONG AFTER HIS ARRIVAL. WE HAVE POUCHED (REGISTRY 3065082 IN CLASSIFIED POUCH WHICH LEFT WASHINGTON APRIL 30) PRESIDENT FORD'S LETTER TO HUA INTRODUCING AMBASSADOR GATES. POUCH SHOULD REACH YOU ABOUT MAY 6, IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE IT ABOUT THEN, LET US KNOW.

FOLLOWING IS OUR TENTATIVE SCENARIO

FOR OBTAINING MEETING WITH HUA: AMBASSADOR

GATES WILL REQUEST COURTESY CALL ON FOREIGN MINISTER

CHILAO THROUGH NORMAL PROCEDURE. IN THAT CALL, METWILL

ATTEMPT TO AVOID A GENERAL TOUR DIMORISON OF THE TYPE

CONTEMPLATED FOR MEETING WITH HUA. HE WILL EXPRESS MOPE

THAT IT WILL BE POSSIBLE FOR HIM TO MEET WITH HUA AND SAY

THAT HE HAS A LETTER FROM PRESIDENT FORD TO MUA. IF

CHILAO ASKS THAT LETTER BE GIVEN TO HIM FOR DELIVERY, HE



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BELIEVE THAT AMBASSADOR GATES WILL HAVE TO COMPLY. OTHER-

WISE, IF AMBASSADOR GATES IS GIVEN AN APPOINTMENT WITH HUA, HE WILL SEND THE LETTER THROUGH THE FOREIGN MINISTRY A DAY IN ADVANCE, SO IT CAN BE TRANSLATED AND READ BY HUA BEFORE THE MEETING. IF AMBASSADOR GATES IS NOT GIVEN AN APPOINTMENT WITHIN THREE TO FOUR WEEKS, HE WILL REPORT BACK FOR INSTRUCTIONS.

FOLLOWING ARE APPROVED TALKING POINTS FOR MEETING WITH HUA. THESE WERE REVIEWED BY AMBASSADOR GATES BEFORE HIS DEPARTURE, BUT WE SAID THAT AFTER HE LOOKS THEM OVER AGAIN IN PEKING, HE COULD LET US KNOW IF HE HAD ANY FURTHER THOUGHTS OR NEEDED ADDITIONAL BACKGROUND ON ANY POINTS. WE WILL UPDATE THE TALKING POINTS AS REQUIRED BY DEVELOPMENTS,

BEGIN TEXT TALKING POINTS

- 1. I WELCOME THIS OPPORTUNITY TO MEET WITH YOU. I LOOK FORWARD TO MY STAY IN PEKING AND TO WORKING WITH YOUR GOVERNMENT TO PROMOTE THE MUTUAL INTERESTS OUR TWO COUNTRIES HAVE REGARDING BOTH VARIOUS GLOBAL MATTERS AND DUR BILATERAL RELATIONS.
- 2. PRESIDENT FORD HAS ASKED ME TO CONVEY TO YOU PERSONALLY HIS CONGRATULATIONS AND GOOD WISHES ON YOUR APPOINTMENT AS PREMIER, I WOULD LIKE TO ADD MY DWN CONGRATULATIONS.
- 3. I BELIEVE YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE LETTER FROM PRESIDENT FORD WHICH I BROUGHT WITH ME, IN WHICH HE EXPRESSED THE HOPE THAT WE COULD EXCHANGE VIEWS ON BOTH INTERNATIONAL MATTERS AND OUR BILATERAL RELATIONSHI,
- 4. AS PRESIDENT FORD HAD EXTENSIVE DISCUSSIONS ON MANY OF THESE MATTERS DURING HIS VISIT TO PEKING IN DECEMBER, I WILL NOT COVER ALL OF THE SAME GROUND AGAIN. HOWEVER, HE HAS ASKED ME TO REITERATE SEVERAL BASIC POINTS, AS WELL AS TO COMMENT ON SOME RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE WORLD.

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D. FOREMOST AMONG THESE IS OUR POLICY TOWARDS THE SOVIET UNION. BECAUSE OF DIFFERING CIRCUMSTANCES, OUR TWO COUNTRIES HAVE SOMEWHAT DIFFERENT POLICIES, AND WE RESPECT THE DECISION YOUR COUNTRY HAS MADE REGARDING YOUR POLICY. FOR OUR PART, WE HAVE A DUAL POLICY. WHILE WE WISH TO IMPROVE OUR BILATERAL RELATIONS WITH THE USSR AND STABILIZE THE INTERNATIONAL SYSTEM, THE UNITED STATES IS DETERMINED TO RESIST SOVIET EXPANSIONISM -- AN OBJECTIVE WHICH OUR TWO COUNTRIES SHARE EVEN IF OUR TACTICS MAY DIFFER.

G. AS YOU MAY KNOW, SOME YEARS AGO I SERVED IN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, INCLUDING A PERIOD AS SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, AND I HAVE MAINTAINED MY INTEREST IN US DEFENSE MATTERS. I CAN THEREFORE SPEAK FROM PERSONAL EXPERIENCE ABOUT THE DETERMINATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO MAINTAIN A STRONG MILITARY POSTURE. PRESIDENT FORD AND SECRETARY KISSINGER ARE ABSOLUTELY COMMITTED TO THIS GOAL WHICH IS REFLECTED IN THE PRESIDENT'S CURRENT DEFENSE BUDGET. DESPITE SOME OF THE RHETORIC IN OUR ELECTION PROCESS, THE US CLEARLY REMAINS THE NUMBER ONE POWER IN THE WORLD IN TERMS OF MILITARY, ECONOMIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL POWER. WE INTEND TO REMAIN SO. AND IT APPEARS THAT THE CONGRESS IS NOW INCREASING ITS SUPPORT TO THIS END.

7. WE HAVE NO ILLUSIONS ABOUT THE SOVIET UNION, AND ON THIS POINT ALSO, THERE IS GROWING AWARENESS AMONG THE AMERICAN PEOPLE OF THE SOVIET UNION'S HEGEMONIC AMBITIONS,

8. AS YOU KNOW FROM YOUR OWN COUNTRY'S EXPERIENCE, IN A COMPLEX AND GLOBAL MATTER SUCH AS THIS ONE, THERE WILL BE OCCASIONAL SETBACKS AS WELL AS SUCCESSES. THE OUTCOME IN ANGOLA HAS SUCH A SETBACK TO DUR MUTUAL INTERESTS. IF WE, TOGETHER WITH OTHER COUNTRIES, HAD BEEN ABLE TO CONTINUE OUR SUPPORT OF THE ANTI-SOVIET ELEMENTS IN ANGOLA, THE OUTCOME WOULD HAVE BEEN DIFFERENT.

9. WE HAVE MADE IT CLEAR TO THE SOVIET UNION, BOTH PUBLICLY AND PRIVATELY, THAT WE WILL REACT STRONGLY TO SECRET.





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FURTHER EFFORTS BY THE SOVIETS TO EXPAND THEIR INFLUENCE BY MILITARY MEANS OR MILITARY PRESSURE WHETHER DIRECTLY OR, AS IN ANGOLA, THROUGH SUPPLY OF MILITARY EQUIPMENT AND SUPPORT OF THE CUBAN TROOPS. WE HAVE ALSO STATED THAT FURTHER SOVIET ACTIONS LIKE THEIR INTERVENTION IN ANGOLA ARE BOUND TO HAVE A SERIOUS EFFECT ON OUR BILATERAL RELATIONS.

10. WE HAVE ALSO MADE IT CLEAR THAT THE UNITED STATES HILL NOT ACCEPT FURTHER CUBAN MILITARY INTERVENTION ABROAD. HE ARE CONCERNED BY THE CONTINUED PRESENCE OF CUBAN TROOPS IN ANGOLA AND BY THE POSSIBILITY THAT THEY WILL BE USED ELSEWHERE. WE WOULD WELCOME YOUR ASSESS= MENT OF SOVIET/CUBAN ACTIVITIES IN SOUTHERN AFRICA.

SECRETARY KISSINGER'S TRIP TO AFRICA WAS DESIGNED TO STRENGTHEN OUR TIES WITH THE AFRICAN NATIONS. WE ARE PURSUING A DUAL-TRACK POLICY OF VIGOROUSLY SUPPORTING MAJORITY RULE IN SOUTHERN AFRICA AND WARNING AGAINST SOVIET/CUBAN INTERVENTION, OUR OBJECTIVE IS THAT AFRICAN COUNTRIES SOLVE THEIR OWN PROBLEMS FREE OF OUTSIDE INTERFERENCE.

12. THE FURTHER CHANGE IN EGYPT'S RELATIONSHIP WITH THE SOVIETS IS A MAJOR FAVORABLE DEVELOPMENT, IT WAS A COURAGEOUS AND STATESMANLIKE MOVE BY , RESIDENT SADAT, AND IS UNDOUBTEDLY VIEWED BY THE SOVIETS AS A MAJOR SET-BACK, HE BELIEVE THAT THE RELATIONSHIP OF TRUST WHICH WE HAVE BUILT WITH : GYPT HELPED TO MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR PRESIDENT SADAT TO TAKE THAT STEP.

13. WE ARE GRATIFIED THAT YOUR GOVERNMENT HAS RESPONDED TO PRESIDENT SADAT'S REQUEST FOR MILITARY EQUIPMENT, AND HOPE THAT YOU WILL FIND IT POSSIBLE TO CONTINUE THAT AID. WE ARE PROVIDING SOME TRANSPORT AIRCRAFT, AND PRESIDENT SADAT UNDERSTANDS WHY WE CANNOT DO MORE THIS YEAR. WE HOPE TO PROVIDE MORE MILITARY AID IN THE FUTURE.

14. WITH RESPECT TO THE ARAB-ISRAEL DISPUTE, WE ARE QUIETLY CONTINUING OUR EFFORTS WITH THE PARTIES SECRET



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CONCERNED TO LAY THE GROUNDWORK FOR FURTHER STEPS
TOWARDS A SETTLEMENT. IT REMAINS A DIFFICULT PROBLEM,
AND WE DO NOT EXPECT A MAJOR BREAKTHROUGH IN THE NEAR
FUTURE. HOWEVER, THE US REMAINS DETERMINED TO HELP
MAINTAIN THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS AND REALIZES THE DANGER
OF STAGNATION-BOTH IN TERMS OF POSSIBLE CONFLICT AND
THE SOVIET ROLE. IT REMAINS OUR PURPOSE TO PREVENT THE
SOVIETS FROM INJECTING THEMSELVES INTO THE PROCESS IN A
KAY THAT WOULD INCREASE THEIR INFLUENCE,

15. ALTHOUGH SYRIA HAS TAKEN A HARDER POSITION THAN EGYPT REGARDING A SETTLEMENT WITH ISRAEL, WE HAVE WELCOMED SYRIA'S EFFORTS TO HELP RESOLVE THE CIVIL STRIFE IN LEBANON. PRESIDENT FORD SENT A SPECIAL EMISSARY, AMBASSADOR BROWN, TO LEBANON TO SUPPORT THOSE EFFORTS. WE THINK PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE AND IN A MANNER THAT HAS REDUCED SOVIET INFLUENCE.

16. OUR RELATIONS WITH CUR EUROPEAN ALLIES REMAINS VERY STRONG. IN ADDITION TO OUR JOINT DEFENSE EFFORTS, THE ALLIANCE IS BEING STRENGTHENED BY UNPRECEDENTED POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION AND COORDINATION.

THE DEFENSE OF EUROPE AND CLOSE TRANS-ATLANTIC TIES ARE PARAMOUNT US INTERESTS AND WILL BE VIGOROUSLY UPHELD.

17. THE SOUTHERN EUROPE SITUATION IS THE MOST TROUBLE SOME. PORTUGAL IS NOT YET STABLE, BUT THE INFLUENCE OF THE PORTUGESE COMMUNIST PARTY, AND THEREFORE SOVIET INFLUENCE, HAS BEEN FURTHER REDUCED.

18. REGARDING SPAIN, FRANCO'S DEATH HAS CREATED LESS INSTABILITY THAN SOME EXPECTED. WE HAVE NEGOTIATED A RENEWAL OF OUR AGREEMENT WITH SPAIN ON OUR HILITARY FACILITIES, AND ARE HOPEFUL THAT IT WILL BE RATIFIED BY OUR SENATE.

19. WE HAVE MADE IT CLEAR TO OUR EUROPEAN FRIENDS. THAT WE WOULD VIEW INCLUSION IN THEIR GOVERNMENTS OF COMMUNIST PARTIES LINKED TO MOSCOH AS SERIOUSLY DETRIMENTAL TO OUR MUTUAL SECURITY INTERESTS.

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20. WE HAVE RECENTLY NEGOTIATED AN OVERALL AGREEMENT WITH TURKEY REGARDING OUR MILITARY FACILITIES THERE AND MILITARY ASSISTANCE, AND ARE NOW NEGOTIATING A SIMILAR AGREEMENT WITH GREECE, BOTH AGREEMENTS WILL REQUIRE CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL, AND THIS MAY TAKE SOME TIME. HOWEVER, THESE DEVELOPMENTS, AND A BETTER PROSPECT FOR IMPROYED RELATIONS BETWEEN GREECE AND TURKEY, SHOULD STRENGTHEN SIGNIFICANTLY NATO'S SOUTHERN FLANK.

21. I WOULD LIKE TO MENTION SEVERAL DEVELOPMENTS IN ASTA, WE HAVE OF COURSE NOTED YOUR RECENT AGREEMENT WITH INDIA TO EXCHANGE AMBASSADORS, WE ASSUME THIS DID NOT PLEASE MOSCOW, BUT WOULD WELCOME YOUR VIEWS ON THIS POINT, AS WELL AS WHETHER YOU EXPECT INDIA TO SUGGEST OTHER STEPS TO IMPROVE ITS RELATIONSHIP WITH YOUR COUNTRY. WE WOULD ALSO WELCOME YOUR ASSESSMENT OF INDIA'S GESTURES TOWARD PAKISTAN.

WITH RESPECT TO JAPAN, OUR RELATIONS ARE IN VERY GOOD SHAPE AND OUR CONSULTATION HAS NEVER BEEN CLOSER. A TROUBLESOME DEVELOPMENT THERE HAS BEEN THE SO-CALLED LOCKHEED AFFAIR. BUT WE HAVE BEEN WORKING CLOSELY WITH THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEM, AND WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT IT WILL NOT HAVE A LASTING EFFECT ON OUR CONTINUING CLOSE RELATIONSHIP.

IN THAILAND, WE HAVE BEEN REVISING OUR MILITARY PRESENCE TO TAKE ACCOUNT OF THE CHANGED SITUATION IN SOUTHEAST ASIA AND TO MINIMIZE THE POSSIBILITY FOR THOSE UNFRIENDLY TO THE US, INCLUDING THE SOVIETS, TO EXPLOIT

THE SITUATION. HOWEVER, THE DETAILS OF OUR MILITARY RELATIONS WITH THAILAND WILL HAVE TO BE NEGOTIATED WITH THE NEW THAI GOVERNMENT.

24. WE HAVE BEEN NEGOTIATING WITH THE PHILIPPINES REGARDING OUR ECONOMIC AND MILITARY RELATIONSHIPS .. WE. ARE CONFIDENT THAT BY RESOLVING SOME OF THE ISSUES THAT MAVE ARISEN WITH THE PASSAGE OF TIME, OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PHILIPPINES WILL SE EVEN STRONGER THAN IT IS



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NOW.

25. SOME WEEKS AGO, AS WE INFORMED YOUR GOVERNMENT THROUGH YOUR LIAISON OFFICE IN WASHINGTON, WF MADE A PROPOSAL TO NORTH VIET-NAM TO HOLD TALKS TO EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITY OF IMPROVING RELATIONS BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES. OUR PROPOSAL WAS A SERIOUS ONE. HOWEVER, HANDI'S RESPONSE, BY RESURRECTING THE PARIS AGREEMENT CLAUSE ABOUT ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE AFTER HAVING KILLED THE AGREEMENT BY ITS MILITARY ACTION LAST YEAR, SUGGESTS TO US THAT HANDI IS NOT NOW INTERESTED IN IMPROVING RELATIONS. OUR OWN ATTITUDE WILL OF COURSE BE STRONGLY INFLUENCED NOT ONLY BY BILATERAL MATTERS BUT ALSO BY WHETHER NORTH VIET-NAM ACTS WITH RESTRAINT TOWARDS THE NEIGHBORING COUNTRIES IN SOUTHEAST ASIA. WE WOULD WELCOME YOUR THOUGHTS ON THIS POINT.

26. REGARDING KOREA, OUR PRIMARY CONCERN REMAINS THAT THERE BE NO DEVELOPMENTS WHICH WOULD HEIGHTEN TENSION BETWEEN NORTH AND SOUTH KOREA. WE CONTINUE TO HOPE THAT WAYS CAN BE FOUND OVER TIME TO REDUCE THOSE TENSIONS. IN THE MEANTIME, WE INTEND TO MAINTAIN OUR MILITARY PRESENCE AS WE BELIEVE IT CONTRIBUTES TO STABILITY IN THE KOREAN PENINSULA.

27. LET ME CONCLUDE WITH A FEW BRIEF REMARKS ABOUT OUR BILATERAL RELATIONS.

28. IN HIS MESSAGE TO YOU UPON YOUR APPOINTMENT AS PREMIER, AND IN THE LETTER I BROUGHT WITH ME, PRESIDENT FORD REAFFIRMED OUR COMMITMENT TO COMPLETE THE PROCESS OF NORMALIZING RELATIONS BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES. HE HAS ASKED ME TO REITERATE THAT THAT IS OUR FIRM POLICY AND TO SAY THAT HE IS CONFIDENT THAT THROUGH OUR JOINT EFFORTS WE CAN ACHIEVE THE OBJECTIVE OF FULLY NORMALIZED RELATIONS.

29. WE RESPECT YOUR VIEW THAT UNTIL THAT TIME, THE FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF SOME ASPECTS OF DUR BILATERAL RELATIONSHIP MAY NOT BE FEASIBLE. NEVERTHELESS, WE HILL WELCOME ANY SUGGESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE, AT ANY TIME,



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REGARDING WAYS IN WHICH OUR RELATIONSHIP CAN BE STRENGTHENED IN OUR MUTUAL INTEREST.

30. I WILL WELCOME YOUR COMMENTS ON THESE OR OTHER MATTERS, AS PRESIDENT FORD ASKED ME TO REITERATE THE IMPORTANCE HE ATTACHES TO CONTINUING THE FRANK EXCHANGE OF VIEWS ON MATTERS OF MUTUAL INTEREST. SISCO

SUBJECT: SEGRETARY'S MEETING WITH HUANG CHEN

1: SECRETARY MET AT HIS REQUEST WITH PROLO CHIEF HUANG CHEN MAY 29, TO REESTABLISH CONTACT AFTER HUANG'S LONG ABSENCE AND TO REVIEW SOME RECENT DEVELOPMENTS, FOLLOWING ARE HIGHLIGHTS.

2. SECRETARY EXPRESSED APPRECIATION FOR THE FRIENDLY RECEPTION GIVEN YOU IN PEKING. "I THINK YOU WILL FIND HIM AN EXCELLENT MAN. HE IS A GOOD FRIEND OF MINE AND OF THE PRESIDENT."

3. SECRETARY NOTED THAT DURING THE PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN SOME CANDIDATES ARE TRYING TO RAISE EMBARRASSING ISSUES ABOUT OUR CRINA POLICY, AND SAID THAT DUPING THIS CAMPAIGN PERIOD RE PHRASE OUR STATEMENTS VERY CAREFULLY TO AVOID "UPHEAVALS." HUANG SAID HE UNDERSTANDS THIS, SECRETARY

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LABELED AS INCORRECT THE REPORT THAT HE HAD TOLD GOLDWATER THAT THE U.S. WOULD NOT NORMALIZE RELATIONS AFTER THE ELECTIONS. INSTEAD, HE TOLD GOLDWATER THAT "WE HAVE MADE NO CONCRETE ARRANGEMENTS." SECRETARY SAID THAT IF ANYTHING COMES UP IN OUR POLITICAL CAMPAIGN THAT RAISES SOME QUESTIONS, PRC SHOULD NOT DRAW CONCLUSIONS WITHOUT CONSULTING US. "WE HAVE CONDUCTED OUR POLICY FOR FIVE YEARS WITH GREAT CARE, AND WILL NOT LET IT FAIL BECAUSE OF TWO MONTHS OF POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS."

- 4. DURING DISCUSSION THIS SUBJECT, HUANG SAID, "SO FAR AS THE CHINESE SIDE IS CONCERNED, WE WILL ALWAYS CARRY DUT THE LINE AND POLICY FORMULATED BY CHAIRMAN MAD, NOT ONLY FOR FOREIGN POLICY BUT ALSO DMMESTIC POLICY."

 SECRETARY SAID HE UNDERSTOOD, AND THAT AS FAR AS WE ARE CONCERNED, WE DEAL WITH CHINESE FOREIGN POLICY, NOT DOMESTIC POLICY.
- S. ON AFRICA, SECRETARY SAID WE ARE NOT GOING TO PERMIT ANOTHER ANGOLA TO DEVELOP AND THAT IF THERE IS ANOTHER SOVIET-SUPPORTED MILITARY ADVENTURE, WE WILL DO SOMETHING. HE EXPLAINED THAT WE ARE ATTEMPTING TO ORGANIZE VARIOUS AFRICAN COUNTRIES IN ORDER TO INCREASE THEIR CAPABILITIES. SECDEF WILL GO TO ZAIRE IN JULY TO DISCUSS MILITARY ASSISTANCE AND WE ARE WORKING CLOSELY WITH ZAMBIA AND OTHER COUNTRIES. LATER IN CONVERSATION SECRETARY MENTIONED THAT WHEN HE GOES TO EUROPE FOR OECD MEETING END OF JUNE, HE PLANS TO MEET WITH BLACK AFRICAN LEADERS AND MAYBE SOUTH AFRICAN LEADERS TO HELP BRING MAJORITY RULE TO RHODESIA.
- 6. HUANG SAID U.S. SHOULD LEARN A LESSON FROM ANGOLA, AND IN RESPOISE TO SECRETARY'S "WHAT LESSON?, SAID "THE FACT THAT THE MILITARY SITUATION IN ANGOLA DEVELOPED TO THE POINT IT DID IS INSEPARABLE FROM U.S. POLICY TOWARDS THE SOVIETS. U.S. POLICY ABETTED THE SOVIET EFFORTS.' 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

ON THE CRUCIAL QUESTION OF A "PEACEFUL SOLUTION" TO THE TAIWAN QUESTION, NOT ONLY DO THE US AND CHINESE POSITIONS DIFFER IN THE SHANGHAI COMMUNIQUE, BUT NONE OF THE 1P CHINESE LEADERS, INCLUDING CHOU, MAD, AND TENG, HAS EVER LIFTED THE THREAT THAT THE TAIWAN PROBLEM WOULD ULTIMATELY HAVE TO

BE RESOLVED BY MILITARY MEANS, WHILE THEIR FORMULATIONS VARY, ON MORE THAN ON OCCASION, INCLUDING STATEMENTS AT THE MOST AUTHORITATIVE LEVEL, THEY HAVE REFERRED TO THE MILITARY LIBERATION OF TAIWAN AS PROBABLY INEVITABLE. THEY HAVE NEVER, HOWEVER, ADVANCED ANY PRECISE TIME FRAME IN WHICH THIS WOULD TAKE PLACE, AND WE NOTE THAT CHANG TOO DIO NOT IMPLY THAT THERE WAS ANY DEADLINE FOR SETTLEMENT OF THE TAIWAN ISSUE, HE ALSO EMPHASIZED THAT THE CHINESE POSITION ON TAIWAN REMAINS UNCHANGED. MOREDVER, FOR ALL HIS DISDAIN ABOUT THE US -- E.G. ON ANGOLA -- CHANG REMINDED SCOTT THAT IN THE INTERNATIONAL ARENA WE HAVE MANY POINTS IN COMMON.

1. ASSISTANT SECRETARY HUMMEL CALLED IN PROLO DEPUTY CHIEF HAN HOU OCTOBER 14 TO CONVEY US DECISION ON CDC COMPUTER CASE, HUMMEL READ PREPARED TALKING POINTS AS FOLLOWS:

-- YOU WILL RECALL THAT WHEN THE PRESIDENT WAS IN PEKING LAST DECEMBER, BOTH THE PRESIDENT AND THE SECRETARY IN-DICATED OUR WILLINGNESS TO BE HELPFUL IN FINDING WAYS TO HANDLE CERTAIN SPECIAL TRADE MATTERS, SUCH AS THE SALE OF COMPUTERS, IN THE LIGHT OF OUR VARIOUS LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

-- SECRETARY KISSINGER ALSO REFERRED TO OUR DESIRE TO BE HELPFUL IN HIS MEETING WITH AMBASSADOR HUANG CHEN ON DECLASSIFIED SECRET

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AUGUST 18. THE SECRETARY NOTED THAT OUR PROCEDURES CREATE CERTAIN PROBLEMS, BUT THAT WE WILL DO OUR BEST TO MAKE SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS IF WE KNOW WHAT YOU WANT, AND WE MAY BE ABLE TO MAKE EXCEPTIONS.

THIS MATTER HAS AGAIN COME TO OUR ATTENTION IN CONNECTION WITH A PENDING SALE TO YOUR COUNTRY OF A COMPUTER SYSTEM MANUFACTURED BY THE CONTROL DATA CORPORATION. THE US-MANUFACTURED COMPUTERS ARE PART OF A SEISMIC OIL EXPLORATION SYSTEM A FRENCH COMPANY WISHES TO SELL TO YOU.

MENTS THAT ARE BEING WORKED OUT BETWEEN CONTROL DATA
CORPORATION AND TECHIMPORT WILL PROVIDE A SATISFACTORY
BASIS FOR CONTINUED COOPERATION BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES
ON TRADE MATTERS OF THIS SORT.

OF SOPHISTICATED COMPUTER SYSTEMS SUCH AS THIS CONTROL DATA COMPUTER PRESENTS US WITH CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE DIFFICULTIES.

IN THESE CASES IT WOULD BE HELPFUL IF THE CHINESE SIDE COULD SUPPLEMENT ITS NORMAL HANDLING OF THESE MATTERS THROUGH COMMERCIAL CHANNELS BY INFORMALLY GIVING US SOME ADVANCE NOTICE OF YOUR INTERESTS. WE MIGHT THEN BE ABLE TO HANDLE THE MATTER MORE EFFICIENTLY THAN WAS POSSIBLE IN THE PRESENT CASE, WHICH CAME TO OUR ATTENTION SOMEWHAT BELATEDLY.

2. HAN HSU RESPONDED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

"REGARDING THE MATTER MENTIONED DURING PRESIDENT FORD'S





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AND SECRETARY KISSINGER'S VISIT TO CHINA AND MENTIONED BY SECRETARY KISSINGER TO HUANG CHEN ON AUGUST 18, WE HAVE DECLARED OUR STANDPOINT CLEARLY. IN THIS CASE, IT MUST BE HANDLED THROUGH COMMERCIAL CHANNELS. IF YOU WANT TO SELL, OK; IF NOT, OK."

SUBJECT: SECRETARY'S MEETING WITH CODEL CURTIS

THE SECRETARY MET FOR OVER AN HOUR WITH MEMBERS OF CODEL CURTIS NOVEMBER 4 (MEMBERS PRESENT INCLUDED SENATOR AND MRS. BAYH, SENATOR AND MRS. YOUNG, SENATOR AND MRS. HOLLINGS, SENATOR AND MRS. JOHNSTON, MRS. STEVENS, MR. AND MRS. HOLTHUIS, AND DICK HART), DURING WHICH HE URGED DELEGATION TO INCLUDE USLO CHIEF AND SEVERAL OF HIS DEFICERS IN PEKING MEETINGS. YOU MAY WISH TO FOLLOW UP ON DELEGATION'S ARRIVAL.

2. IN OTHER RESPECTS, SECRETARY PROVIDED GENERAL REVIEW OF PRC DOMESTIC DEVELOPMENTS AND BRIEF DISCUSSION OF US-PRC RELATIONS. HE URGED THE DELEGATION TO LEAVE THE TAIWAN ISSUE ALONE IN THEIR MEETINGS WITH THE CHINESE, NOT ONLY BECAUSE CHINESE MAY NOT BE SURE FOR WHOM DELEGATION IS SPEAKING BUT BECAUSE OF IMPLICATIONS FOR NEXT ADMINISTRATION. HE SUGGESTED THAT IF SUBJECT OF NORMAL--SECRET-

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IZATION AROSE, DELEGATION SHOULD INDICATE SUPPORT BUT NOT IN TERMS OF ANY SPECIFIC FORMULA. HE EXPRESSED HOPE DELEGATION COULD ALSO STRESS ELEMENTS OF CONTINUITY IN US

POLICY IN VIEW OF UNCERTAINTY ABROAD AS TO WHAT NEW ADMINISTRATION MEANS.

3. THE SECRETARY NOTED THAT SUBJECTS OF SUPPLYING MILITARY EQUIPMENT OR ENGAGING IN TECHNICAL COOPERATION HAVE NOT BEEN DISCUSSED WITH CHINESE. HE ADDED THAT THERE IS NO PLAN FOR THE SALE OF MILITARY EQUIPMENT NOR HAVE THE CHINESE EVER ASKED FOR IT. HE ALSO NOTED POSSIBILITY OF STRONG SOVIET REACTION IF US MOVED IN THIS DIRECTION.
