- I AM INCREASINGLY CONCERNED OVER THE GROWING NUMBER OF ARTICLES WHICH ARE APPEARING IN THE PRESS INDICATING THAT U.S. -PRC RELATIONS ARE DETERIORATING . THAT U.S. DIPLOMATS IN PEKING HAVE NO CONTACT WITH CHIMESE, THAT U.S .- CHINESE CULTURAL EXCHANGES HAVE DVINDLED TO NIL, ETC. AL JENKINS' VISIT TO TAIWAN (REF A) AND TERHORST ARTICLE IN CHICAGO TRIBUNE (REF B) ARE ONLY TWO THE MOST RECENT OF SUCH INDICATORS, BUT THEY MAY BE READ BY CHINESE AS OFFICIALLY INSPIRED SIGNALS OF U.S. DISILLUSION WITH OUR RELATIONSHIP.
- THERE MAY BE SOME WHO WOULD ARGUE WE SHOULD NOT DISABUSE THE CHINESE OF THIS NOTION. WE WOULD CERTAINLY LIKE INCREASED CONTACTS AND GREATER CHINESE FLEXIBILITY AND WE SHOULD CONTINUE TO PRESS THEM ON THIS. ON THE OTHER HAND, THE FACTS ARE THAT WE HAVE ABOUT AS MUCH ACCESS TO CHINESE OFFICIALS AS ANY OTHER NON-SOCIALIST COUNTRY AND OUR HIGH LEVEL DELEGATIONS HAVE BEEN IN SOME CASES MORE. GIVEN FIRST RATE TREATMENT AND ACCESS, AND OUR CULTURAL EXCHANGES, WITH A FEW EXCEPTIONS HAVE PROCEEDED VERY SMOOTHLY.
- I CAN SEE NO ADVANTAGE TO US IN LETTING THIS IMPRESSION OF DISILLUSIONMENT GO TOO FAR. THE CHINESE ARE NOT GOING TO CHANGE THEIR SPOTS. THIS IS A CLOSED SOCIETY, AND NO ONE EXPECTS THE KIND OF ACCESS ONE WOULD NORMALLY HAVE, EVEN IN THE SOVIET UNION. I ALSO DOUBT THAT A CHINESE SENSE OF U.S. DISPLEASURE IN THESE AREAS IS LIKELY TO HAVE ANY POSITIVE INFLUENCE ON THEIR ATTITUDES REGARDING THE LARGER ISSUES BETWEEN OUR TWO GOVERNMENTS. I SUGGEST, THEREFORE, THAT WE CONSIDER AN ON-THE-RECORD INTERVIEW OR A CLEARLY IDENTIFIABLE BACK-GROUNDER IN WHICH WE SET THE RECORD STRAIGHT ON, AMONG OTHER

- I. IF YOU FEEL THAT SOME SMALL OUTWARD SIGNS OF PROGRESS MUST BE SEEN FOLLOWING YOUR VISIT YOU MAY WANT TO CONSIDER SOME USLO EXPANSION AS A SMALL BUT VISIBLE STEP WHICH WOULD BE IN KEEPING WITH NOVEMBER 14, 1973 COMMUNIQUE STATEMENT: "THE SCOPE OF THE FUNCTIONS OF THE LIAISON OFFICE SHOULD CONTINUE TO BE EXPANDED."
- 2. WE HAVE SOME SPECIFIC THOUGHTS ON THIS WHICH WE WILL BE PREPARED TO DISCUSS WITH YOU ON YOUR ARRIVAL.
- 3. ANY INCREASE IN USLO PERSONNEL WOULD NECESSITATE MORE OFFICE SPACE, MORE LIVING QUARTERS AND MORE ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT. FIRM PRC AGREEMENT ON THIS WOULD BE ESSENTIAL -- PARTICULARLY ON SPACE REQUIREMENT.
- 4. OUR STAFF IS HIGHLY REGARDED HERE. IF ANY EXPANSION IS CONTEMPLATED I WOULD LIKE TO SEE US RETAIN HIGH LEVEL OF CHINESE LANGUAGE CAPABILITY.
- 5. I AM NOT PRESSING FOR ANY INCREASE BUT IF IT IS IN THE INTEREST OF OVERALL POLICY TO SHOW PROGRESS IN THIS AREA ABOVE FUNCTIONS COULD BE CONSTRUCTIVELY UTILIZED.
- 6. WITH REFERENCE TO STATE 249466, WE WILL GIVE NO INTERVIEWS ON OR OFF THE RECORD. UNFOUNDED SPECULATION STILL PERSISTS ON POLICY DETERIORATION BUT USLO WILL STAY CALM AND COOL. I DID NOT WANT TO OVERSTATE THE CASE, BUT FELT YOU SHOULD BE AWARE, AS PRC OFFICIALS ARE, OF THIS SPECULATIVE CLIMATE.

YOUR MAJESTY!

IN THE SPIPIT OF OUR CLOSE FRIENDSHIP AND CONSULTATION, PRESIDENT FORD HAS ASKED ME TO ENSURE THAT YOU ARE PROMPTLY INFORMED OF THE RESULTS OF HIS MFETING IN VLADIVOSTOK WITH SOVIET GENERAL SECRETARY BRFZHNEY. I HAVE ASKED AMBASSADOR HELMS TO CONVEY TO YOU THE MIDDLE EAST PORTION OF THE COMMUNIQUE ISSUED AT THE CONCLUSTON OF THIS MEETING, ALONG WITH THIS PERSONAL REPORT ON THE TALKS.

THE ESSENTIAL POINT IS THAT PRESIDENT FORD HELD FIRMLY TO THE STRATEGY THAT WE HAVE BEEN PURSUING, WHICH I DISCUSSED WITH

YOUR MAJESTY AT SOME LENGTH DURING MY RECENT VISIT TO TEHRAN.

WHILE AGREEING THAT CONTINUED US/SOVIET CONSULTATION AND COOPERATION REMAIN IMPORTANT, THE PRESIDENT STRESSED THE NECESSITY OF CAREFUL PREPARATION FOR ANY FURTHER DIPLOMATIC MOVES. PUBLICLY IN THE COMMUNIQUE, THE PRESIDENT AGREED THAT THE "WORK" OF THE GENEVA CONFERENCE SHOULD RESUME AS 500N AS POSSIBLE. IN HIS PRIVATE TALKS. HE EMPHASIZED THE NECESSITY OF LAYING THE GROUNDWORK SYSTEMATICALLY AND CHOOSING CAREFULLY THE APPROPRIATE TIME FOR SUCH A MOVE.

THUS, OUR CONSULTATIONS WITH THE NEGOTIATING PARTIES WILL CONTINUE FROM THE BASIS WHICH I DESCRIBED TO YOUR MAJESTY DURING MY RECENT VISIT. IN THIS CONNECTION, I WANT YOUR MAJESTY TO KNOW THAT I HAVE ASKED FOREIGN MINISTER ALLON TO COME TO WASHINGTON SHORTLY AFTER MY RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES IN ORDER TO CONTINUE OUR CONSULTATIONS ON HOW BEST NOW TO PROCEED. THE TALKS IN VLADIVOSTOK IN NO WAY LIMITED OUR ABILITY TO PROMOTE EURTHER PROGRESS TOWARD PEACE IN THE DIRECTION WHICH I HAVE DESCRIBED TO YOU. IT IS OUR INTENTION TO PURSUE THESE EFFORTS WITH ENERGY AND DEDICATION IN THE WEEKS AHEAD.

YOUR MAJESTY WILL NOTICE THAT THE COMMUNIQUE REFLECTS THE CONTINUING AMERICAN CONVICTION THAT THE LEGITIMATE INTERESTS OF THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE MUST BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT IN ANY JUST AND LASTING SOLUTION. AS I TOLO YOUR MAJESTY IN DISCUSSING THE CONSEQUENCES OF THE SUMMIT CONFERENCE OF ARAB LEADERS IN RABAT. THE QUESTION IS NOT WHETHER LEGITIMATE PALESTINIAN INTERESTS SHOULD BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT IN THE NEGOTIATIONS BUT HOW THIS CAN BE DONE, THIS IS THE ISSUE THAT MUST BE ADDRESSED IN THE MORE DIFFICULT SITUATION CREATED BY THE RABAT CONFERENCE. AS I HAVE EXPLAINED TO YOUR MAJESTY, THE OVERRIDING CONCERN OF THE UNITED STATES AT THIS POINT IS TO ACHTEVE FURTHER PROGRESS IN THE NEGOTIATIONS ALREADY LAUNCHED SO THAT A NEW SITUATION WILL BE CREATED WHICH MAY MAKE FURTHER STEPS POSSIBLE.

IN SHORT, WHILE THE TALKS IN VLATIVOSTOK SIGNIFICANTLY ADVANCED US/SOVIET RELATIONS ON OTHER MATTERS OF GLOBAL IMPORTANCE, THE U.S. REMAINS FREE TO PURSUE THE STRATEGY IN THE MIDDLE EASY WHICH HAS RESULTED IN THE PROGRESS OF THE PAST YEAR. THE

YOUR IMPERIAL MAJESTY:

WITH REFERENCE TO MY PREVIOUS MESSAGE TO YOU I WANTED TO GIVE YOU A FULLER RUNDOWN ON THE STRATEGIC ARMS DISCUSSION IN VLADIVOSTOK.

AS YOU KNOW, WHILE WE WISH TO REACH AN AGREEMENT THAT WILL FURTHER CURB THE STRATEGIC ARMS RACE, WE HAVE NO INTENTION OF TAKING ANY STEPS THAT WOULD WEAKEN WESTERN DEFENSES OR HINDER OUR OVERALL INTERNATIONAL STRATEGY THAT WE HAVE DISCUSSED. I AM PLEASED TO TELL YOU THAT IN THE TALKS BETWEEN PRESIDENT FORD AND GENERAL SECRETARY BREZHMEV WE MADE SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS TOWARD A TEN YEAR FOLLOW-ON AGREEMENT TO SALT I THAT SHOULD BOTH ENHANCE GLOBAL STABILITY AND ASSURE CONTINUED STRONG

WESTERN DEFENSES.

THE SOVIET STOE FIRST PROPOSED THAT IT BE PERMITTED A LARGER NUMBER OF CENTRAL SYSTEMS WHILE WE COULD HAVE A SLIGHTLY LARGER NUMBER OF MIRVED MISSILES, THIS HAD BEEN THE PATTERN IN OUR DISCUSSIONS OVER RECENT MONTHS. WHILE IN PRINCIPLE THERE WERE POSSIBILITIES IN THIS APPROACH IF THE ACTUAL NUMBERS WERE SATISFACTORY. IT MIGHT HAVE HAD SOME PSYCHOLOGICAL DISADVANTAGES IN FORMALIZING A SOVIET EDGE IN NUMBERS OF CENTRAL SYSTEMS. EVEN THOUGH SUCH AN EDGE WOULD BE MEANINGLESS IN STRATEGIC TERMS.

AFTER THE PRESIDENT HELD FIRM, THE SOVIET SIDE CHANGED ITS
POSITION TO AGREE TO EQUAL NUMBERS IN CENTRAL SYSTEMS AS WELL
AS MIRVED MISSILES. IN ADDITION THE SOVIETS DROPPED THEIR INSISTENCE
ON INCLUDING OUR FORWARD BASED SYSTEMS WITH OUR ALLIES OR ON THE
SOVIETS RECEIVING COMPENSATION FOR OTHER THREATS TO THE USSR.
WE REACHED, AGREEMENT ON ACTUAL NUMBERS AS WELL AS THESE BASIC
PRINCIPLES. ACCORDINGLY, I THINK WE HAVE OVERCOME THE MAJOR
POLITICAL AND CONCEPUTAL PROBLEMS FOR A NEW SALT AGREEMENT.
ALTHOUGH THERE ARE MANY DIFFICULT TECHNICAL PROBLEMS TO WORK
OUT, PRIMARILY REGARDING VERIFICATION, THERE IS A VERY GOOD
CHANCE THAT WE WILL BE ABLE TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT NEXT SUMMER
WHEN GENERAL SECRETARY BREZHNEY VISITS THE UNITED STATES.

YOUR MAJESTY, I THINK THIS HOPEFUL PROGRESS DEMONSTRATES THE SOVIET NEED TO MAINTAIN THE MOMENTUM OF GOOD RELATIONS WITH US. THE AGREEMENT THAT NOW SEEMS POSSIBLE IS DUE IN PART TO OUR FIRM STANCE IN THE NEGOTIATIONS AND THE CLEAR SIGNALS WE HAVE SENT ON OUR PADINESS TO CONTINUE TO DEVELOP OUR DEFENSES IF MOSCOW IS NOT PREPARED TO BE REASONABLE. I THINK THE COURSE WE ARE ON SHOULD BE IN THE INTERESTS OF OUR ALLIES AND FRIENDS AND CONTRIBUTE TO A MORE SECURE WORLD.

I WILL CONTINUE, YOUR MAJESTY, TO KEEP YOU INFORMED ON THESE IMPORTANT NEGOTIATIONS, WARM REGARDS, HENRY A. KISSINGER.

I. I BELIEVE WE SHOULD APPROACH THE AUSTRIANS TUESDAY AND LET THEM START THE PROCESS OF CONSULTATIONS WITH THE OTHER SC MEMBERS RIGHT AWAY. PLEASE INSTRUCT SCALL TO DO SO.
