WANG HAT JUNG, VICE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS CHOU PEISYUAN, CHINESE ACADEMY OF SCIENCES MANCY TANG, DEPUTY DIRECTOR, AMERICAN AND OCEANIAN DEPARTMENT, MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS MADAME KANG MR. FAN. AND DTHER MEMBERS OF THE CHINESE PEOPLES INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS MR LT: WELCOME TO YOU AND TO YOUR FRIENDS. SENATOR MANSFIELD: THANK YOU VERY MUCH. WE ARE VERY PLEASED TO BE HERE AND TO SEE THE NEW PROGRESS THAT HAS OCCURRED IN CHINA. PLEASE ALLOW ME TO EXPRESS MY CONDOLENCES AND THOSE OF MRS MANSFIELD, SENATOR AND MRS GLENN AND DUR ENTIRE PARTY AT THE PASSING OF CHAIRMAN MAD. MR LI: THANK YOU VERY MUCH. YOU ARE AN OLD FRIEND. HOW MANY TIMES HAVE YOU VISITED CHINA? SENATOR MANSFIELD: THREE TIMES SINCE LIBERATION MR. LIN AND BEFORE LIBERATION? SENATOR MANSFIELDS THREE TIMES ALSO. MR. LI: YOU ARE AN OLD PRIEND INDEED, WHAT PLACES HAVE YOU VISITED? SENATOR MANSFIELD: WE WERE FORTUNATE TO VISIT SINKIANG AND KHANGTUN. WE HAVE BEEN TO PEKING THREE TIMES ON THIS JOURNEY. HE ALSO WENT TO NANKING AND WE WILL LEAVE FROM SHANGHAI. MR LIE SO YOU ONLY HAVE TIBET LEFT TO SEE. SENATOR MANSFIELD: AND INNER MONGOLIA. MR LIE YOUR FRIEND OR SCHLESINGER WENT TO TIBET AND ALSO TO SINKIANG. SENATOR MANSFIELD: HE ALSO WENT TO KHEILIN, FRANK VALEO SERVED IN KWEILIN DURING THE ANTI-JAPANESE WAR. HE WAS A SERGEANT THEN. MR LIE WHAT YEAR WAS THAT. MR VALEDI IN 1944. MR LI: THAT WAS TOWARD THE END OF THE ANTI-JAPANESE WAR. PERSONALLY I CEASED FIGHTING AFTER 1949. THE MECHANIZATION OF FARMS, THE USE OF TRACTORS, MORE TRUCKS AND THE TREMENDOUS NUMBER OF BICYCLES ARE VERY IMPRESSIVE, YOU ARE EVEN APPROACHING A TRAFFIC PROBLEM IN PEKING. MR LIE WE HAVE MADE SOME PROGRESS AND WE HAVE MADE SOME SUCCESS ACTING UNDER THE GREAT LEADERSHIP OF CHAIRMAN MAD. STILL WE ARE NOT SATISFIED. COMPARED WITH YOUR SITUATION WE ARE A COMPARATIVELY BACKWARD

MR LT: I AGREE BUT IN ONE ASPECT HE ARE MORE ADVANCED \*\*\* THE SIZE OF OUR POPULATION. SENATOR MANSFIELD: HOW BIG DO YOU ESTIMATE THE SIZE OF YOUR POPULATION? MR LI: IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO SAY (BU CHIH TAO). MR LI: WE SAY WE HAVE 889,000,000 PEOPLE BUT OUR MINISTRY OF COMMERCE SAYS WE MAVE 900,000,000 BUT THEY HAVE TO SUPPLY FOOD TO THE PEOPLE AND THEY ALWAYS EXAGGERATE. EXDIS HONG KONG PLEASE PASS TO SENATOR MANSFIELD SENATOR MANSFIELD: THE VICE PREMIER IS NOTED FOR HIS ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL KNOWLEDGE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THE NEW FIVE YEAR PLAN PROJECTED FOR CHINA IS NOW BEING IMPLEMENTED. CAN YOU GIVE US SOME INFORMATION ABOUT WHAT THE PLAN ENVISAGES? MR. LIE YOU ARE LAUDING ME TOO HIGHLY. SENATOR MANSFIELD: I DON'T THINK SO. MR. LIE WE HAVE DRAWNLP ANOTHER PIVE YEAR PLAN. THE GENERAL CONCEPT IS TO MAKE FURTHER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE COUNTRY. UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF CHAIRMAN MAD'S REVOLUTIONARY LINE AND OF THE BASIC LINE OF GRASPING CLASS STRUGGLE AS THE KEY LINK AND FOLLOWING CHOU EN-LAI'S REPORT TO THE FOURTH NATIONAL PEAPLES CONGRESS (ON INDUSTRY, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY) WE BASE OURSELVES ON SELF-RELIANCE AND ARE SELF-RELIANT IN THE MAIN. 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PEOPLE KNOW NO LIMITS. THAT CALLS FOR SOME HARD LIVING CONDITIONS FOR OUR PEOPLE. WE WILL IMPROVE THE STANDARD OF LIVING OF THE PEOPLE WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF PRODUCTION'. BUT THE STANDARD OF LIVING HAS NOT IMPROVED SO MUCH BECAUSE IN OUR PINANCIAL BUDGET. OUR INCOME AND OUR SPENDING MUST BALANCE, BECAUSE IF THERE IS IMBALANCE WE WOULD HAVE TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF MONEY PRINTED AND IT IS NOT GOOD TO CIRCULATE TOO LARGE AN AMOUNT OF MONEY. THIS HOULD AFFECT THE STABILITY OF PRICES. OUR POLICY IS TO ORGANIZE OUR ECONOMY WITH PRIORITY GIVEN TO AGRICULTURE FIRST AND THEN TO LIGHT INDUSTRY AND THEN TO HEAVY INDUSTRY. AGRICULTURE MUST BE DEVELOPED FIRST BECAUSE PEOPLE MUST EAT AND THEY MUST HAVE CLOTHES TO HEAR. WE STRESS HAVING SUFFICIENT FOOD. AS FOR THE QUALITY OF THE POOD, I CANNOT SAY IT IS AT THE PRESENT TIME VERY HIGH. HE STRESS SUFFICIENT CLOTHING. HE STRESS KEEPING WARM ENOUGH BUT WE BT NOT STRESS EVERYONE BEING DRESSED UP IN A FANCY WAY. SOME OF OUR COMRADES ESPECIALLY OUR WOMEN COULD AFFORD TO DRESS MORE PRETTILY BUT THEY DON'T SEEM TO WANT TO DO SO. I THINK THAT IS A GOOD THING, FOR INSTANCE AS FOR THE CHINESE LADIES HERE TODAY NO ONE TELLS THEM THAT THEY MUST WEAR A CERTAIN UNIFORM. SENATOR MANSFIELD: BUT THEY LIKE TO BE IN STYLE AND ARE IN STYLE, JUST AS WE ARE. MR LIE OUR NATIONAL ECONOMY IS VERY COMPLEX MATTER. YOU KNOW OF COURSE DURS IS A PLANNED ECONOMY. SOMETIMES WE COMMIT MISTAKES. WHEN WE SEE WE HAVE COMMITTED A MISTAKE WE CORRECT IT. LOOKING AT THE GENERAL SITUATION WE SEE THAT THE SPIRITS OF OUR PEOPLE ARE HIGH. THE SOVIET UNION SAYS IT HAS NO BOURGEOIS. AS IT SEE IT BREZHNEY IS THE CHIEF BOURGEDIS. THERE ARE THOSE IN THE INTERNATIONAL SCENE WHO ARE FEARFUL THAT SIND SOVIET RELATIONS WILL CHANGE WITH THE PASSING OF CHAIRMAN MAD AND THEY SEEM MORTALLY AFRAID THAT THIS WILL HAPPEN. WE HAVE FUNDAMENTAL DIFFERENCES IN IDEOLOGY AND ESPECIALLY ON THE

THIS IS IN STARK CONTRAST TO THE LAST FEW YEARS WHEN WE HAD THE TURMOIL OF THE WATERGATE AFFAIR WHICH SHOOK THE UNITED STATES' I THINK THESE FACTORS SHOULD BE KEPT IN MIND. PRESIDENT FORD HOULD NOT HAVE ASKED ME TO UNDERTAKE THIS JOURNEY UNLESS HE WAS VERY INTERESTED IN MOVING TOWARDS NORMALIZATION OF RELATIONS CALLED FOR IN THE SHANGHAI COMMUNIQUE, A COPY OF THE PRESIDENT'S LETTER TO ME HAS BEEN SENT TO THE PRC LIAISON OFFICE IN HASHINGTON. I WOULD MORE THAT THE CHINESE GOVERNMENT AND PEOPLE WOULD UNDERSTAND THESE FACTORS AND RECOGNIZE THAT HE HAVE MANY KNOTS TO UNTIE. IT IS EASY TO TIE A KNOT, BUT NOT AS EASY TO UNTIE ONE, I HOULD HOPE THE WORD "PATIENCE" WOULD BE USED IN COMPREHENDING AND UNDERSTANDING THE RELATIONS WHICH EXIST BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES AT THIS TIME. LI: KNOTS ARE ALSO EASY TO UNTIE. IT ONLY CALLS FOR THE SEVERANCE OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS, THE WITHDRAWAL OF YOUR TROOPS AND THE ABROGATION OF THE TREATY. MANSFIELD: WE UNDERSTAND THE JAPANESE FORMULA, BUT KNOTS OVER A PERIOD OF TIME BECOME HARDER AND THEY ARE NOT EASY TO UNTIE, AND THEY TAKE TIME. LI: AND I MAY ADD ONE POINT, AS TO HOW THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA IS TO SETTLE THE TAIWAN ISSUE, BY FORCE OR BY PEACEFUL MEANS, IS OUR INTERNAL AFFAIR AND WE DON'T WANT INTERPERENCE FROM FOREIGNERS. PATIENCE IS POSSIBLE. AS FAR AS I KNOW, OUR VIEWS ON THIS ISSUE WERE DISCUSSED WITH PRESIDENT NIXON, PRESIDENT FORD, SECRETARY KISSINGER AND MANY AMERICANS, I THINK OUR VIEWS ARE WELL KNOWN. MANSFIELD: YES, THEY ARE VERY WELL KNOWN. LI: YOU TALKS ABOUT PATIENCE. IT IS A POSSIBILITY. WE HAVE TIME ENOUGH. MANSFIELD: MR. VICE PREMIER, YOU MENTIONED YOUR DIFFICULTY WITH THE SOVIET UNION BASED ON IDEOLOGY, BUT ISN'T ANOTHER PACT TO BE CONSIDERED. ARE THERE NOT TERRITORIAL ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED? 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YEARS NOW AND THERE HAS NOT BEEN MUCH PROGRESS YET. MSNASIFLE: IT IS STILL A BONE OF CONTENTION. LI: OF COURSE, IT IS A MATTER OF CONTENTION AND SOMETIMES ACUTE CONTENTION. MANSFIELD: MAY I SAY WE WERE VERY IMPRESSED BY THE PEOPLE OF SINKIANG, THEY WERE CALM AND UNWORRIED AND GAVE US THE FEELING THAT THEY WERE SURE OF THEMSELVES AND WERE PREPARED FOR ANY EVENTUALITY WHICH MIGHT OCCUR. LI: OF WHAT USE IS IT TO WORRY DAY IN AND DAY OUT? IF IT BT

EXDIS IS GOING TO RAIN AND IF SOMEONE IS GOING TO MARRY YOUR MOTHER, WHAT CAN YOU DO? YOU JUST HAVE TO HARDEN YOUR ACCORDING TO THE CHAIRMAN'S TEACHING, HE WILL HEARTS NOT ATTACK IF WE ARE NOT ATTACKED, BUT IF WE ARE ATTACKED WE WILL CERTAINLY COUNTERATTACK, FIGHTING IS JUST SUCH A THING. YOU HAVE TO FIGHT WHETHER YOU'RE AFRAID OR NOT. IT'S BETTER TO GET A GOOD SLEEP AND THEN FIGHT AGAIN WHEN ONE IS MORE RESTED. WE HAVE HAD THAT EXPERIENCE IN THE LONG PERIODS OF WAR. EXDIS SENATOR GLENN: THAT CAN BE A MAJOR PACTOR IN CHINA'S RELATIONS WITH THE REST OF THE WORLD. HOW WILL CHINA USE THIS RESOURCE IN INTERNATIONAL COMMERCET ARE THERE PLANS TO MOVE IN THAT DIRECTION? 3. THE FOUR ARE ALSO SAID BY UNSIGNED POSTERS AND IN ONE CASE BY "A RELIABLE CHINESE" IN PEKING SPEAKING CONFIDENTIALLY TO A JAPANESE DIPLOMAT -TO HAVE COLLABORATED WITH SOVIET REVISIONISM, AN ACCUSATION LEVELLED AGAINST THE LOSERS IN EACH CHINESE POLITICAL STRUGGLE DURING THE LAST DECADE, GIVEN THE REPUTATION OF THE RADICAL QUARTET FOR STRIDENT ANTI-SOVIETISM, THERE SEEMS LITTLE LIKELIHOOD THAT SUCH COLLUSION TOOK PLACE, BUT THE RECORD OF CHANG CHUN-CHIAD IN THE 1950'S, PARTICULARLY HIS GLOWING TRIBUTE TO THE SOVIET UNION WRITTEN AFTER HIS 1954 TRIP THERE, COULD PROVIDE AMPLE AMMUNITION TO THOSE SEEKING TO MAKE THIS CASE.

AN EAST GERMAN EMBOFF MADE NO MENTIONOF SUCH A MEETING IN AN OCTOBER 20 DISCUSSION WITH USLO OFFICER, BUT HE VOLUNTEERED THAT HIS COUNTRY WAS "OPTIMISTIC" ABOUT PROSPECTS FOR IMPROVED RELATIONS WITH CHINA. REFERRING VAGUELY TO "RECENT" CONVERSATIONS WITH CHINESE OFFICIALS, HE SAID THAT THE CHINESE EVIDENCE AN "UNDERSTANDING OF THE OBJECTIVE NEED" FOR A BETTER RELATIONSHIP WITH THE SOVIET UNION AND EASTERN EUROPE.

4. THE SAME JAPANESE EMBOFF (PROTECT) ALSO ADVISED USLO OFFICER OF A "DISTURBING" CONVERSATION HE MAD HAD WITH A SOVIET EMBOFF, WHO ON OCTOBER 3 HAD "ACCURATELY PREDICTED# THAT HUA KUO-FENG WOULD SOON BE FORCED TO MOVE AGAINST THE RADICALS AND THAT YAD WEN-YUAN AT MINIMUM WOULD FALL. EVEN THOUGH THE SOVIET EMBOFF HAD PRESENTED HIS CONCLUSION AS AN ANALYTICAL JUDGMENT BASED ON INTENSIFYING MEDIA POLEMICS (HE CITED THE SEPTEMBER 59 ARTICLE IN PEOPLE'S DAILY BY TSINGHUA UNIVERSITY AUTHORS), HIS AIR OF EXTREME CONFIDENCE LED THE JAPANESE EMBOFF TO WONDER, ESPECIALLY IN RETRO-SPECT, IF THE SOVIETS MIGHT NOT HAVE BEEN TIPPED OFF IN SOME FASHIOMIBY THE CHINESE.

5. ADDRESSEES WILL HAVE NOTED NONA REPORT THAT YU CHAN ON OCTOBER 8 MET AND HAD A "FRIENDLY TALK" WITH GERD RUGE, RESIDENT CORRESPONDENT OF DIE HELT. ACCORDING TO RUGE, YU CHAN RATHER FORCEFULLY QUESTIONED THE RELIABILITY OF THE U.S. RUGE, WHO HAS SINCE LEFT PEKING FOR A YEAR AT HARVARD, WAS SURPRISED THAT CHINESE PUBLICIZED THIS MEETING SINCE IT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE CONFIDENTIAL AND ON A DEEP BACKGROUND OR GUIDANCE BASIS, IT WAS RUGE'S PLAN TO WRITE A STORY ON CHINESE VIEWS WHICH WOULD IN FACT BE THOSE EXPRESSED BY YU CHAN (HE DO NOT KNOW IF THIS STORY HAS APPEARED IN GERMAN OR U.S. PAPERS).

6. AUSTRALIANS TELL US THAT SOVIET EMBOFFS ARE GOING AROUND THE DIPLOMATIC COMMUNITY CLAIMING THAT THEY HAVE FOUND A SUDDEN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF CHINESE PROUD OF THEIR ABILITY TO SPEAK RUSSIAN WELL. DEAN BT

1. ASSISTANT SECRETARY HUMBEL CALLED IN PROLO DEPUTY CHIEF HAN HOU OCTOBER 14 TO CONVEY US DECISION ON COCCOMPUTER CASE, HUMBEL READ PREPARED TALKING POINTS AS FOLLOWS:

-- YOU WILL RECALL THAT WHEN THE PRESIDENT WAS IN PEKING LAST DECEMBER, BOTH THE PRESIDENT AND THE SECRETARY INDICATED OUR WILLINGNESS TO SE PELPFUL IN FINDING WAYS TOHANDLE CERTAIN SPECIAL TRADE NATTERS, SUCH AS THE SALE OF COMPUTERS, IN THE LIGHT OF OUR YARIOUS LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

SECRETARY KISSINGER ALSO REFERRED TO OUR DESIRE TO BE HELPFUL IN HIS MEETING WITH AMBASSADOR HUANG CHEN ON

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AUGUST 18. THE SECRETARY NOTED THAT OUR PROCEDURES CREATE CERTAIN PROBLEMS, BUT THAT WE WILL DO OUR BEST TO MAKE SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS IF WE KNOW WHAT YOU WANT, AND WE MAY BE ABLE TO MAKE EXCEPTIONS.

CONNECTION WITH A PENGING SALE TO YOUR COUNTRY OF A COMPUTER SYSTEM MANUFACTURED BY THE CONTROL DATA COMPORATION. THE US-HANUFACTURED COMPUTERS ARE FART OF A SEISHIC OIL EXPLORATION SYSTEM A FRENCH COMPANY WISHES TO SELL TO YOU.

UNDER WHICH THIS SALE WOULD BE CONCLUDED; AND ARE SATISFIED THAT THE SYSTEM WILL BE USED FOR ITS STATES PURPOSE, WHICH IS PETROLEUM EXPLORATION.

EXCEPTIONAL BASIS. WE HOPE THAT THE SPECIFIC ARRANGE.
MENTS THAT ARE BEING WORKED OUT BETWEEN CONTROL DATA
CORPORATION AND TECHINPORT WILL PROVIDE A SATISFACTORY
BASIS FOR CONTINUED COOPERATION BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES
ON TRADE MATTERS OF THIS SORT.

THE HOPE THAT THE CHINESE SIDE REALIZES THAT THE SALE OF SOPHISTICATED COMPUTED SYSTEMS SUCH AS THIS CONTROL DATA COMPUTER PRESENTS US WITH CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE DIFFICULTIES.

THE SECRETARY MENTIONED TO AMBASSADOR HUANG CHEN, IN THESE CASES IT WOULD BE HELPFUL IF THE CHINESE SIDE COULD SUPPLEMENT ITS NORMAL HANDLING OF THESE MATTERS THROUGH COMMERCIAL CHANNELS BY INFORMALLY GIVING US SOME ADVANCE NOTICE OF YOUR INTERESTS. WE HIGHT THEN BE ABLE TO HANDLE THE MATTER MORE EFFICIENTLY THAN WAS POSSIBLE IN THE PRESENT CASE, WHICH CAME TO OUR ATTENTION SOMEWHAT BELATEDLY.

2. HAN HSU RESPONDED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

"REGARDING THE HATTER HENTIONED DURING PRESIDENT FORDIS





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AND SECRETARY KISSINGER'S VISIT TO CHINA AND MENTIONED BY SECRETARY FISSINGER TO HUANG CHEN ON AUGUST 18, WE HAVE DECLARED OUR STANDPOINT CLEARLY. IN THIS CASE, IT MUST BE HANDLED THROUGH COMMERCIAL CHANNELS. IF YOU WANT TO SELL, OK; IF NOT, OK."
