(SNED) AT A RECEPTION ON THE EVENING OF 31 MAY 75 AT WHICH RO WAS ABLE TO INTRODUCE THE NEW US AMBASSADOR TO THAILAND TO GEN KRIANGSAK CHAMANAN, C OF S, SUPREME COMD HQ; TO ADM SA NGAT, CINC, RTN; AND ACM KAMON DECHATUNGKHA, CINC, RTAF, RD WAS ABLE TO DISCUSS THE CAMBODIAN SHIP E-311 AT RATHER GREAT LENGTH WITH BOTH ADM SA NGAT AND HIS DIR OF INTELL, RADM AMPON. THE TWO ADMIRALS DISPLAYED SOME PIQUE AS REGARDS THE INFO LEAK TO THE NEWSPAPER WHICH HAD

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CAUSED THEM SOME SERIOUS EMBARRASSMENT, BUT OTHERWISE THEY WERE FRIENDLY AND STRAIGHTFORWARD. BOTH OFFICERS, SEPARATELY, INDICATED THAT THEY HAD CONDUCTED LONG AND INTENSIVE INTERROGATIONS OF THE CREW, TOGETHER AND SEPARATELY.
