Acting on guidance other than my own, the Department of State has dispatched the telegram at Tab C to Embassy Madrid. It contains the text of a message of congratulations from the President to Prince Juan Carlos. Aside from the fact that there has been no editorial review at the White House, all considered, it's not a bad effort. However,

- the President's name is wrong -- State has forgotten that he uses a middle initial
- 2) no thought has been given to the Vice President's role in this.

The message at Tab A for your approval to Ambassador Stabler would request him to correct the President's name and prepare the message of congratulations for personal presentation by the Vice President to Prince Juan Carlos at the appropriate moment.

The message for your approval to Jon Howe at Tab B would advise him of the message and to be expecting that it will be ready for personal delivery by the Vice President following his arrival in Madrid.

The following background is germane. As of mid-morning November 21, State was not preparing such a message. NSC Secretariat inquired if one was needed. This staff called the Spanish desk pointing out that the Prince would take his oath within 24 hours, and we also asked Jeanne Davis to request State Secretariat to have a message LDXed to the White House for clearance as soon as possible. Al Adams on the Secretary of State's staff asked me to clear by telephone. I told him I preferred to have State LDX the message for clearance, as had earlier been requested by our Secretariat. I told him it was possible that the President might wish to see it (considering that he had acted on similar messages earlier in the day) and because we had work to do relating to the Vice President. I subsequently received the message for information. It would appear from the initials that Jerry Bremer signed off for you.
