1. THE CHINESE HAVE AGREED TO A SIMPLE ANNOUNCEMENT ON OCTOBER 6 THAT SECRETARY KISSINGER WILL VISIT PEKING BEGINNING OCTOBER 19. WE HAVE PROPOSED OCTOBER 23 AS THE COMPLETION DATE, AND WE EXPECT THE CHINESE WILL AGREE.

1. MFA WILL BE LARGELY CLOSED DOWN FOR THE NEXT THREE DAYS, OCTOBER 1 THROUGH 3, FOR NATIONAL DAY. BUT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE THEREAFTER WE SHOULD BEGIN DISCUSSION WITH THEM ON ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE SECRETARY'S VISIT.

2. ON PAST EXPERIENCE, MFA WILL WANT MOST URGENTLY:

- FLIGHT INFO INCLUDING CREW LISTS;
- LIST OF OFFICIAL PARTY IN PROTOCOL ORDER;
- PRESS LIST;
- PASSPORT DATA FOR ALL OF THE ABOVE;
- REQUIREMENTS FOR HOUSING, INCLUDING OFFICE SPACE, AND FOR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION;
- REQUIREMENTS FOR ADDITIONAL COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES.

3. IF HOUSING REQUIREMENTS ARE TO BE ROUGHLY THE SAME AS THOSE FOR THE SECRETARY'S LAST VISIT (SEE STATE 253484, 1974), WE SUGGEST THAT CHINESE BE ASKED TO PROVIDE AT LEAST THREE RATHER THAN LAST YEAR'S TWO ROOMS AT THE GUEST HOUSE FOR USE AS OFFICES. THIRD ROOM WOULD BE FOR SENIOR OFFICIALS NOT ON THE SECRETARY'S IMMEDIATE STAFF AND FOR USLO PERSONNEL.

1. FOLLOWING IS AGREED TEXT OF SIMULTANEOUS ANNOUNCEMENT
MADE BY US AND PRC AT NOON OCTOBER 6 (WASHINGTON TIME):

"IT HAS BEEN AGREED UPON THROUGH CONSULTATIONS THAT DR.
HENRY A. KISSINGER, UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF STATE AND
ASSISTANT TO THE U.S. PRESIDENT FOR NATIONAL SECURITY
AFFAIRS, WILL VISIT THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA FROM
OCTOBER 19 THROUGH OCTOBER 23, 1975."

2. AMBASSADOR ANDERSON WAS ASKED IF THERE WOULD BE ANY OTHER STOPS INVOLVED. HE REPLIED THAT THE SECRETARY WOULD BE STOPPING IN JAPAN BOTH COMING AND GOING, AND WOULD BE MEETING WITH SENIOR JAPANESE OFFICIALS. HE SAID THERE WOULD BE NO OTHER STOPOVERS.

3. ASKED WHAT THE PURPOSE OF THE TRIP WOULD BE, ANDERSON SAID THAT IT HAS BECOME THE SECRETARY'S CUSTOM TO HAVE AN ANNUAL REVIEW OF OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PRC. ON THIS TRIP, HE WILL ALSO BE DISCUSSING THE PRESIDENT'S UPCOMING VISIT TO CHINA.

4. IN JAPAN, ANDERSON SAID THAT THE SECRETARY WILL BE CONSULTING WITH SENIOR OFFICIALS ON MANY SUBJECTS, INASMUCH AS THE JAPANESE ARE ONE OF OUR CLOSEST ALLIES. HE ALSO EXPECTS THAT THE SECRETARY WOULD BE DISCUSSING HIS TRIP TO CHINA.

5. ASKED WHO FROM THE DEPARTMENT WOULD BE ACCOMPANYING THE SECRETARY, HE SAID THAT HE DID NOT HAVE ALL OF THE DETAILS AT THIS TIME, BUT HE ASSUMED THAT HABIB, LORD AND PROBABLY OTHERS FROM THE EA BUREAU WOULD BE GOING.

6. IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION FROM A JAPANESE REPORTER AS TO WHETHER OR NOT JAPANESE OFFICIALS WOULD BE FULLY INFORMED ABOUT THE TALKS IN CHINA, ANDERSON SAID THAT HE COULD ASSURE THAT THERE WOULD BE THE CLOSEST OF CONSULTATIONS WITH THE JAPANESE ON THE PRC DISCUSSIONS. KISSINGER

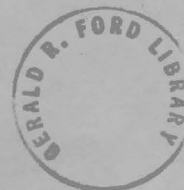

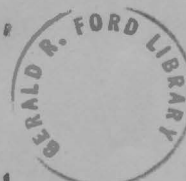

EXPANDED USLO

1. BY PEKING 1914, WE MENTIONED CERTAIN ADDITIONS TO THE USLO STAFF THAT COULD BE MADE IN THE NEAR FUTURE WITHOUT RISKING TOO MUCH REDUNDANCY BETWEEN THE FUNCTIONS OF USLO AND CONGEN HONG KONG. AS INDICATED IN THAT MESSAGE, WE ALREADY HAVE A SPACE PROBLEM AT USLO AND ARE HOPING TO MAKE SOME MODEST CHANGES IN OUR PRESENT BUILDING TO BETTER ACCOMMODATE OUR PRESENT STAFF PLUS MINOR INCREASES.

2. SINCE THERE SEEMS LITTLE DOUBT THAT WE WILL EVENTUALLY BE SHIFTING MUCH OF THE HONG KONG WORK TO PEKING, WE BELIEVE THERE WOULD BE SUBSTANTIAL ADVANTAGE IN OBTAINING CHINESE AGREEMENT NOW TO EXPANDING OUR FACILITIES TO PUT US IN A POSITION, AT AN APPROPRIATE TIME, TO MAKE THAT SHIFT. WE WILL BE NEEDING A BIGGER BUILDING AND MORE LAND, WITH RECREATIONAL FACILITIES-- IN OTHER WORDS THE SAME ARRANGEMENTS ENJOYED BY OTHER MAJOR COUNTRIES' EMBASSIES HERE AS WELL AS SOME MINOR ONES.

3. I BELIEVE THAT TO THIS END IT WOULD BE MUCH WISER, AND RELATIVELY SIMPLE, FOR THE BASIS OF THIS TO BE

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LAI DURING THE SECRETARY'S VISIT BY MEANS OF THE SECRETARY SEEKING, IN DIRECT BRIEF CONVERSATION WITH THE CHINESE, PRC HIGH-LEVEL AGREEMENT TO THE IDEA, SIMPLY, THAT WE SHOULD HAVE NEW AND LARGER FACILITIES AND THAT THE CHINESE WILL BE PREPARED TO COOPERATE WITH ME IN WORKING OUT AN APPROPRIATELY LOCATED AND APPROPRIATELY AMPLE PARCEL OF LAND. ONCE THIS IS DONE, WE CAN PROCEED MORE EFFECTIVELY TO NEGOTIATE THIS OUT WITH THE DIPLOMATIC SERVICES BUREAU. TO BEGIN TO DO SO AT THIS DATE WOULD HELP ALSO TO POSITION US ON THE GROUND TO OPERATE AS A "NORMALIZED" EMBASSY ONCE THAT DECISION IS MADE IN THE FUTURE.

4. THE CHINESE AGREED TO EXPANDING "SCOPE OF FUNCTIONS" OF THE LIAISON OFFICES IN 1973; AND PRCLO IN WASHINGTON HOUSES SOME SEVENTY STAFFERS. WE WOULD ENVISION, ONCE A DECISION IS MADE TO CENTER OUR CHINA FIELD OPERATION IN PEKING RATHER THAN HONG KONG, AN EVENTUAL DOUBLING, PERHAPS, OF OUR STAFF.

5. WE MIGHT BE ABLE TO DEVISE AN ANNOUNCEMENT PERTAINING TO USLO EXPANSION THAT COULD BE INTERPRETED VREIBLY AS A SMALL FURTHER SIGN OF PROGRESS IN OUR RELATIONS.

6. DEPARTMENT MAY WISH TO REPEAT TO CONGEN CROSS, WITH WHOM THIS MESSAGE HAS NOT BEEN DISCUSSED.
