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THE PARAMOUNT CHALLENGE OF OUR TIME. AND THE DE-CISIONS INVOLVED MUST BE TAKEN IN AN ERA MORE COMPLEX. MORE UNCERTAIN, AND POTENTIALLY MORE DISCORDANT THAN ANY WE HAVE KNOWN BEFORE.

10. IN THIS TIME OF TESTING AND IN A WORLD OF SOVEREIGN STATES -- DISPARATE IN CULTURE, IDEOLOGY AND AIMS --THE UNITED NATIONS CAN PROVIDE AN INVALUABLE PORUM FOR BUILDING THE CONSENSUS WE NEED TO KEEP THE PEACE, TO FURTHER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TO ENHANCE MAN-KIND'S FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS. THE PRINCIPLES VOICED IN THE CHARTER ENDURE AS TIMELESS EXPRESSIONS OF MANKIND'S DEEPEST ASPIRATIONS. IN ADDITION, THE COUNCIL ON FOREIGN RELATIONS HAS PRESSED VERY HARD FOR A MEETING IN NEW YORK WITH PRESIDENT SADAT AND THE FOREIGN POLICY ASSOCIATION HAS MADE A SIMILAR INVITATION WHICH HAS BEEN ENDORSED IN WRITING BY OVER TWENTY SENATORS AND CONGRESSMEN.
