.. WE HAVE JUST LEARNED THAT BOTH SENATOR SPARKMAN AND  
CONGRESSMAN MORGAN HAVE INVITED SADAT TO MEET IN A JOINT  
SESSION WITH THE COMMITTEES ON FOREIGN RELATIONS AND  
INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS, PREFERABLY THE MORNING OF TUESDAY,  
OCTOBER 28. WE THINK SUCH A MEETING WOULD BE VERY IMPOR-  
TANT ESPECIALLY IN TERMS OF OUR AID REQUESTS FOR EGYPT.  
HOWEVER, THE DRAFT SCHEDULE HAS SADAT FULLY OCCUPIED ON  
THAT MORNING WITH THREE MEETINGS THAT PROBABLY CANNOT BE  
FIT ELSEWHERE ON THE SCHEDULE WITHOUT CANCELLING SOME  
OTHER EVENT. THE THREE MEETINGS ARE: 10:30 POSSIBLE  
SECOND MEETING WITH PRESIDENT FORD; 11:30 OFF-THE-RECORD  
MEETING WITH SELECTED EDITORS AND COLUMNISTS; AND 12:15  
BRIEF MEETING WITH ARAB AMBASSADORS ASSIGNED TO WASHINGTON,  
FOLLOWED BY YOUR LUNCHEON AT 1-00 P.M. THE THOUGHT OCCURS  
TO US THAT THE MEETING WITH PRESIDENT FORD MAY NOT BE  
NECESSARY IN VIEW OF THE FOLLOWING OTHER OCCASIONS ON  
WHICH THE TWO PRESIDENTS WILL BE TOGETHER: THE FIRST MEET-  
ING AT 11:30 MONDAY, OCTOBER 27, FOLLOWING SADAT'S ARRIVAL;  
THE WHITE HOUSE DINNER THAT EVENING; THE SADAT RETURN

DINNER ON TUESDAY EVENING, OCTOBER 28; THE MEETING IN  
FLORIDA ON NOVEMBER 2 AND THE MEETING YOU RECOMMENDED FOR  
THE MORNING OF NOVEMBER 5 BEFORE SADAT ADDRESSES THE JOINT  
SESSION OF CONGRESS. THUS, IT WOULD SEEM THE TWO PRESI-  
DENTS WILL HAVE CONSIDERABLE TIME TOGETHER, BUT WE WANTED

SUBJECT: SADAT VISIT: MEETING WITH CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES

FOR AMBASSADOR FROM THE SECRETARY

1. WE HAVE JUST LEARNED THAT SENATOR SPARKMAN AND CHAIRMAN MORGAN HAVE JOINTLY INVITED PRESIDENT SADAT TO MEET WITH THE SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE JOINTLY, PREFERABLY ON THE MORNING OF TUESDAY, OCTOBER 28. THIS INVITATION CAME TO OUR ATTENTION AFTER THE SESSION OCTOBER 16 WITH HASSAN KAMEL AND THE ADVANCE TEAM. DURING THAT SESSION, THE MORNING OF OCTOBER 28 WAS FILLED AS FOLLOWS: 10:30 A.M. SECOND MEETING WITH PRESIDENT FORD (TENTATIVE); 11:30 OFF-RECORD MEETING WITH SELECTED EDITORS AND COLUMNISTS AT BLAIR HOUSE; 12:15 BRIEF MEETING WITH ARAB AMBASSADORS AT BLAIR HOUSE; 1:00 P.M. LUNCHEON HOSTED BY SECRETARY AND MRS. KISSINGER.

2. THERE IS NO ROOM ELSEWHERE ON THE SCHEDULE TO SHIFT

ONE OF THESE THREE MEETINGS WITHOUT CANCELLING SOMETHING ELSE THAT THE EGYPTIANS BELIEVE IS DESIRABLE. BOTH WE AND THE EGYPTIAN ADVANCE TEAM FELT THE MEETING WITH EDI-



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TORS AND COLUMNISTS COULD BE VERY USEFUL AND THE EGYPTIANS ATTACH IMPORTANCE TO THE BRIEF MEETING WITH THE ARAB AMBASSADORS; CANCELLATION OF THE LATTER WOULD IN ANY CASE NOT PROVIDE SUFFICIENT TIME FOR SADAT TO MEET WITH THE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES. THE THOUGHT OCCURS TO US THAT CONSIDERATION MIGHT BE GIVEN TO DROPPING THE TENTATIVE MEETING WITH PRESIDENT FORD IN VIEW OF THE SEVERAL OTHER OCCASIONS WHEN THE TWO PRESIDENTS WILL BE TOGETHER. AS TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED, PRESIDENT SADAT WOULD MEET WITH PRESIDENT FORD FOR AN HOUR OR SO IMMEDIATELY AFTER HIS ARRIVAL IN WASHINGTON; THEY WOULD BE TOGETHER AT THE WHITE HOUSE DINNER ON OCTOBER 27 AND THE SADAT DINNER ON OCTOBER 28; THEY WOULD BE TOGETHER IN FLORIDA ON NOVEMBER 27 AND THE SECRETARY HAS RECOMMENDED THAT PRESIDENT FORD MEET WITH PRESIDENT SADAT FOR HALF AN HOUR BEFORE SADAT ADDRESSES THE JOINT SESSION OF CONGRESS ON NOVEMBER 5. (THIS LAST RECOMMENDATION IS NOT KNOWN TO HASSAN KAMEL AND THE ADVANCE TEAM.) THUS, THE TWO PRESIDENTS WILL HAVE CONSIDERABLE TIME TOGETHER FOR DISCUSSIONS, BUT THE EGYPTIANS MAY ATTACH AT LEAST SYMBOLIC IMPORTANCE TO THE MEETING ON TUESDAY MORNING, OCTOBER 28.

3. I WOULD LIKE YOU TO DISCUSS THIS MATTER WITH FAHMY, TELLING HIM THAT WE ATTACH CONSIDERABLE IMPORTANCE TO SADAT'S MEETING WITH THE TWO CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES. THE INVITATION COMES AT THE INITIATIVE OF THE TWO CHAIRMEN AND THE MEETING COULD BE HELPFUL IN SECURING CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL OF THE AID PROGRAM FOR EGYPT AND OTHER PROPOSALS THAT WE MAY SUBMIT TO THE CONGRESS. THE MEETING WOULD BE AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY FOR SADAT TO EXPLAIN HIS POLICIES TO A SELECT GROUP AND TO INCREASE UNDERSTANDING ON THE HILL OF EGYPTIAN AND ARAB POINTS OF VIEW. WHILE

1. AP (FREED): "WASHINGTON -- SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER LEFT FOR PEKING TODAY TO ASSESS THE UNCERTAIN CHINESE LEADERSHIP SITUATION AND TO TEST THE WIND FOR PRESIDENT FORD'S JOURNEY TO ASIA. KISSINGER AND HIS WIFE BOARDED THEIR JET AT ANDREWS AIR FORCE BASE AFTER SAYING GOODBYE TO CHINESE AND JAPANESE DIPLOMATS.

"NO SHARP ISSUES ARE ON THE AGENDA WHEN KISSINGER GETS TO PEKING SUNDAY, AND HE HAS SAID THERE WILL BE NO DRAMATIC MOVEMENT TOWARD ESTABLISHING DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS. ON THE OTHER HAND, KISSINGER SAYS HIS TRIP AND FORD'S POST-THANKS-GIVING DAY VISIT TO PEKING SHOW THAT THE PACE TOWARD NORMAL RELATIONS IS BEING MAINTAINED ON A STEADY AND REGULAR BASIS.

"THE FACT THAT KISSINGER IS GOING TO CHINA ESSENTIALLY TO PREPARE FOR FORD'S SUBSEQUENT VISIT IS ABOUT THE ONLY PARALLEL TO HIS FIRST VISIT TO THE MAINLAND IN 1971. THEN, ACTING AS PRESIDENT NIXON'S NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISER, KISSINGER USED THE PRETENSE OF ILLNESS TO DROP OUT OF SIGHT AND FLY SECRETLY FROM PAKISTAN TO PEKING. THAT EXCEEDINGLY DRAMATIC MOVE BROKE THE HOLD OF COLD WAR ANTAGONISMS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. KISSINGER ALSO FOUND THAT CHINESE LEADERS WANTED BETTER RELATIONS AND WERE EAGER FOR



NIXON TO VISIT.

"THE CIRCUMSTANCES THIS TIME ARE DIFFERENT WITH THE FORD TRIP LARGELY SYMBOLIC OF THE IMPROVED RELATIONS. IN DETERMINING THE PROSPECTS OF LONG-TERM RELATIONS, KISSINGER AIMS DURING THIS TRIP TO ASSESS THE MAINLAND LEADERSHIP SITUATION.

"THE MEN WHO DECIDED TO WELCOME NIXON AND SHIFT THE OLD RELATIONSHIP ARE REPORTEDLY ALL BUT USELESS BECAUSE OF OLD AGE AND ILLNESS. MAO TSE-TUNG, THE LEGENDARY CHAIRMAN OF THE CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY, IS NEARLY 82 AND DESCRIBED BY U.S. EXPERTS AS SERIOUSLY REDUCED IN POWER, EITHER BY HIS OWN DESIGN OR SIMPLY BY THE NATURE OF AGED WEAKNESS. CHOU EN-LAI, THE 77-YEAR-OLD PREMIER, HAS BEEN IN A HOSPITAL FOR WEEKS AND HAS CANCELED APPOINTMENTS WITH FOREIGN VISITORS BECAUSE OF ILLNESS. SOME AMERICAN SOURCES ARE EXTREMELY DOUBTFUL THAT CHOU WILL EVER LEAVE THE HOSPITAL AND ARE SKEPTICAL OVER KISSINGER'S CHANCES OF SEEING THE MAN WHO MOVED CHINA OUT OF GLOBAL ISOLATION FOUR YEARS AGO.

"KISSINGER WILL BE DEALING MOSTLY WITH DEPUTY PREMIER TENG HSIAO-PING, A SHADY FIGURE LITTLE KNOWN OUTSIDE CHINA. THE TWO MEN HAVE MET THREE TIMES BEFORE WHILE ATTENDING UNITED NATIONS SESSIONS IN NEW YORK.

"AS ALWAYS, THE SECRETARY WILL BE DOING A BALANCING ACT BETWEEN PEKING AND MOSCOW. A KISSINGER TRIP TO PEKING INEVITABLY STIRS UNREST IN THE SOVIET UNION, WHICH FEARS AN AMERICAN-CHINESE ALLIANCE WOULD DOMINATE ASIA. PEKING IS SUSPICIOUS OVER THE DETENTE POLICY WASHINGTON AND MOSCOW PROCLAIM IS ESSENTIAL TO PEACE."

2. UPI: "WASHINGTON -- SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER DEPARTED FOR CHINA TODAY TO SET THE STAGE FOR AN UPCOMING PEKING VISIT BY PRESIDENT FORD -- A VISIT WHICH COULD OPEN A NEW CHAPTER IN SINO-AMERICAN RELATIONS . . . .

"ADMINISTRATION SOURCES SAID KISSINGER, WHOSE SECRET MISSION TO PEKING OPENED THE DOOR FOR FORMER PRESIDENT NIXON'S DRAMATIC 1971 FLIGHT TO CHINA, WILL LAY THE GROUNDWORK FOR SINO-AMERICAN RELATIONS CONDUCTED NOT ONLY WITHOUT NIXON BUT MINUS CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY CHAIRMAN MAO TSE-TUNG, 82, AND PREMIER CHOU EN-LAI, 77. . . .

"NO SPECTACULAR ANNOUNCEMENTS OR DECISIONS ARE EXPECTED FROM THE SUNDAY-THROUGH-THURSDAY KISSINGER VISIT, WHICH WILL COME IN A STABLE ATMOSPHERE FOSTERED BY BETTER TRADE, CULTURAL AND OTHER TIES BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND

FOR THE SECRETARY FROM EAGLEBURGER

1. BILL HYLAND WILL CALL BOB MCNAMARA TOMORROW TO SET UP AN APPOINTMENT TO BRIEF HIM ALONG THE LINES YOU AND I DISCUSSED IN THE CAR THIS AFTERNOON. I TALKED TO MCNAMARA AND SUGGESTED THAT AFTER HE HAS THE HYLAND BRIEFING HE PROCEED ALONG THE LINES SUGGESTED BY YOU TO ME IN THE CAR.
2. WE ARE WORKING ON A NEW SINAI MEMO WHICH WILL BE CLEARED WITH SCOWCROFT AND SENT TO YOU EARLY NEXT WEEK.
3. I WILL TRY TO SEE MEL LAIRD EARLY NEXT WEEK.
4. THE PIKE COMMITTEE STAFF HAS ASKED THAT I APPEAR TO GIVE SWORN TESTIMONY BEFORE THE STAFF ON CYPRUS NEXT WEEK.

I FEEL I HAVE NO CHOICE BUT TO AGREE TO GO, BUT, SUBJECT TO YOUR APPROVAL, WILL TAKE THE LINE THAT I WAS YOUR EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT AT THE TIME OF THE CYPRUS CRISIS AND CONSEQUENTLY NOT A POLICY LEVEL OFFICER. AS A RESULT I WILL BE BOUND BY YOUR RESTRICTIONS AND THEREFORE UNABLE TO DISCUSS ANYTHING OTHER THAN ISSUES OF FACT.

5. WHILE I DON'T WANT TO USE THE ARGUMENT UNLESS I HAVE TO, I FEEL THAT MY CLOSE AND INTIMATE RELATIONSHIP WITH YOU AS YOUR EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT MAKES IT TOTALLY INAPPROPRIATE FOR ME TO DISCUSS IN ANY WAY YOUR VIEWS ON THE CYPRUS ISSUE. IF IT COMES TO THAT, I WILL INSIST THAT THEY MUST ASK THESE QUESTIONS OF YOU. IN ADDITION MY MEMORY IS HONESTLY VERY HAZY ON DETAILS AND I HAVE NO INTENTION OF TRYING TO REFRESH MY MEMORY BY READING BACK FILES OVER THE COURSE OF THE NEXT FEW DAYS.

6. I UNDERSTAND THAT THE PIKE COMMITTEE ALSO PLANS TO CALL HARTMAN AND SISCO FOR SIMILAR SWORN TESTIMONY LATER IN THE WEEK AND THAT THEY MAY TRY TO TALK TO HELMS ABOUT THE MIDDLE EAST IN 1972 WHEN HE IS IN TOWN (AS HE MAY WELL BE FOR THE CHURCH COMMITTEE NEXT WEEK).

7. FINALLY, WE HAVE JUST RECEIVED A LETTER FROM THE PIKE COMMITTEE STAFF WITH A BROADSIDE REQUEST FOR CABLES, MEMORANDA, LETTERS, ETC., HAVING TO DO WITH THE ITALIAN ELECTIONS IN 1972. THEY ARE ALSO TRYING TO FIND OUT WHERE GRAHAM MARTIN IS BECAUSE THEY INTEND TO INSIST THAT HE APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMITTEE STAFF AND PROBABLY THE COMMITTEE. I WILL BE MEETING WITH BILL HYLAND AND MONROE LEIGH EARLY NEXT WEEK TO DISCUSS HOW WE OUGHT TO HANDLE THIS QUESTION. WE WILL COME TO YOU WITH A TELEGRAM AS SOON AS WE HAVE SORTED THE PROBLEM OUT.

8. I HAVE TOLD BILL ROGERS THAT YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO DO LATIN AMERICA IN NOVEMBER. INGERSOLL

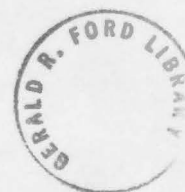

THE PRINCIPLES VOICED IN THE CHARTER ENDURE AS TIMELESS EXPRESSIONS OF MANKIND'S DEEPEST ASPIRATIONS. THEY STILL PROVIDE A BASIS AND AN INSPIRATION FOR COMMON EFFORT AND ULTIMATE AGREEMENT AMONG NATIONS. OUR IDEALS ENDURE; IT IS OUR PRACTICES WE MUST ALTER. TO FULFILL THE PROMISE OF THE CHARTER, THE WORLD ORGANIZATION MUST RECOGNIZE CERTAIN BASIC TRUTHS:

- THAT DIVERSITY OF EXPRESSION AND BELIEF MUST BE PRESERVED;
- THAT INTERNATIONAL DECISIONS MUST RECOGNIZE THE INTEREST OF ALL THOSE INVOLVED, SO ALL WILL HAVE A STAKE IN THEIR IMPLEMENTATION;
- THAT PRACTICAL AND CONCRETE MEASURES PROVIDE THE ONLY SURE WAY TO LASTING PROGRESS; AND





-- THAT MUTUALITY OF BENEFIT IS ESSENTIAL TO SUSTAINED COOPERATION.

11. AS AMERICANS REVIEW OUR NATION'S PAST IN THIS BICENTENNIAL PERIOD WE SEE RENEWED CAUSE FOR CONFIDENCE THAT UNITY CAN BE FASHIONED FROM, YET PRESERVE, THE CREATIVE DIVERSITY OF PEOPLES, DESPITE THE VARIETY OF HISTORY, INTEREST AND VALUES WHICH TEND TO DIVIDE NATIONS, COOPERATION AND CONSENSUS ARE POSSIBLE. INDEED, THEY ARE IMPERATIVE, FOR IN TODAY'S WORLD, INJUSTICE, WHEREVER IT OCCURS, DIMINISHES THE STATURE OF ALL; ECONOMIC WARFARE, FOR WHATEVER CAUSE, JEOPARDIZES THE PROSPERITY OF ALL; AND MILITARY CONFLICT, ON ANY SCALE, THREATENS THE SURVIVAL OF ALL.

WM KNOWING OF YOUR SCHEDULED VISIT TO CHINA, OUT AS A PRELIMINARY TO THE PRESIDENT'S TRIP AND TO ACCOMPANY PRESIDENT FORD, I WOULD LIKE TO BRING A MATTER TO YOUR ATTENTION. AS YOU ARE AWARE, CONGRESS HAS APPOINTED A SELECT COMMITTEE TO TRY TO PROVIDE A UNIFIED NATIONAL EFFORT TO OBTAIN A PROPER ACCOUNTING FOR PERSONS STILL MISSING AND THE RELEASE OF PERSONS NOW HELD IN SOUTHEAST ASIA.

3. IT IS THE FEELING OF THE COMMITTEE THAT THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA MIGHT BE OF ASSISTANCE IN THIS MISSION. ACCORDINGLY THE COMMITTEE HAS REQUESTED THAT I WRITE TO YOU ASKING THAT YOU TRY TO OBTAIN ANSWERS TO SEVERAL QUESTIONS WHICH HAVE ARISEN DURING THE COMMITTEE'S DISCUSSIONS. THESE QUESTIONS ARE ATTACHED.

4. THE COMMITTEE FULLY REALIZES THE SENSITIVITY OF RELATIONS WHICH EXISTS BETWEEN THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE UNITED STATES, BUT WE FEEL VERY STRONGLY THAT WE SHOULD PURSUE EVERY POSSIBLE AVENUE IN SEEKING A RESOLUTION TO THIS MATTER WHICH IS A RESULT OF THE VIETNAM CONFLICT.
