MEMORANDUM FOR: THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: WEEKLY REPORT #9, Week Ending September 6, 1975

This past week's report is necessarily brief as activities in conjunction with the National Committee meeting have occupied most of our time and a detailed report on the results of the meeting will be submitted at the end of this week. Highlights of the past week, however, are as follows:

ORGANIZATION - Dan Duykendall and John Dellenbach have volunteered to touch base with former Members of Congress and get their endorsements for the campaign.

Dick Mastrangelo has been hired and will begin work on September 15th, as the Northeast Regional Coordinator. New Hampshire will be his first assignment, and he will be in that State on Election Day to begin PFC organizing. Dick was Eliot Richardson's assistant and former Executive Director of the Massachusetts State Party. B. Oglesby, a former Dick Ogilvie aide, was hired as a mid-West coordinator, although his first assignment will be to touch base in Florida and assess the overall situation there.

STATE COMMITTEES

John Tower and I jointly announced the Texas PFC Committee in Dallas on Saturday, after meeting with most of the 103 members. It is a broad representative Committee of Republicans, and the announcement received good press coverage throughout Texas.

LEGAL

The initial reaction of the General Counsel at the FEC was highly favorable to Phil Buchen's letter on apportionment of mixed official/political travel expenses, and he even commented that in certain areas the recommendations were stronger than the FEC might actually have imposed.

FINANCE - \$6,660 was raised during the week for a total of \$637,451.

A Finance Chairman was confirmed in Louisiana - Mr. W. K. McWilliams, President, McMoran Oil Exploration Company - bringing the total to 17. An additional 10 Chairmen have been cleared.
