

DINNER HONORING THE GOVERNORS

The White House
March 7, 1974
8:00 p.m.

Briefing information for the Vice President.

Dress: Black tie.....long dresses for the ladies.

Arrival: At 6:55 p.m. Lt. Col. Sardo will meet you at the North Portico and escort you to the East Room. Mrs. Ford will arrive separately at 6:50 at the South Portico and will be met by Lt. Col. Blake and escorted to the East Room. By 7:00 p.m. all guests will have arrived and will have been escorted to the East Room for cocktails.

Entrance: At approximately 7:01 the President and Mrs. Nixon will proceed to the State Floor using the elevator... pause in the Grand Hall for Ruffles and Flourishes and the announcement...and enter the East Room as "Hail to the Chief" is played.

The receiving line will be the President and Mrs. Nixon.

You and Mrs. Ford will lead the guests through the receiving line.... You will be escorted by Lt. Col. Sardo through to the State Dining Room for dinner.

Dinner: Round tables will be used. Lt. Col. Sardo will escort you and Mrs. Ford to your designated seats.

The Strolling Strings will perform during dessert.

As the dinner draws to a close, the President will rise and make remarks.

After Dinner:

You and Mrs. Ford will be escorted by Lt. Col Sardo to the Blue Room for coffee, liqueurs and cigars.

At an appropriate time, you and Mrs. Ford will be escorted by Lt. Col Sardo to your seats in the East Room for the entertainment.

Entertainment:

After guests are seated in the East Room, the President and Mrs. Nixon will enter.

The President will proceed to the stage and introduce Miss Pearl Bailey.

At the conclusion of the performance, the President and Mrs. Nixon will go forward and thank Miss Bailey. You and Mrs. Ford may do so afterward as well.

Full press coverage of the entertainment.

Departure:

The President and Mrs. Nixon will be escorted to the Family Quarters.

There will be champagne and dancing for the guests in the Grand Hall.

Your limousine will be at the North Portico when you and Mrs. Ford desire to depart. Lt. Col. Sardo will escort you to the limousine.
