## **Gerald R. Ford Vice Presidential Papers: Videotapes and Films, 1973-74**

### **Series Description**

#### ***Videotapes*** (7 hours)

13 video tapes, both 3/4" cassettes and 2" reels, containing interviews, news summaries, and appearances by the Vice President. Included is "Jerry Ford Day" at South Middle School in Grand Rapids and two reports on the events surrounding the swearing-in of Ford as Vice President. All of the tapes were produced by the networks or local television stations.

Arranged chronologically.

#### ***Films*** (4,500 feet)

Two 16mm color films including 2000 feet from the ABC Network's coverage of the announcement of Gerald Ford as Vice Presidential nominee by President Richard Nixon. The film contains interviews with government officials and a Ford biography. The other film (2,500 feet) is Gerald Ford's appearance on the Dick Cavett Show. A copy of the film is available in 3/4" videotape. Both films are direct off-air copies.
