Summary Description

The Shirley Peck Barnes audiovisual series consists primarily of photographs related to Barnes's involvement with the group Friends of Children of Vietnam (FCVN) and "Operation Babylift," the evacuation of orphans from Saigon during April 1975. Subjects include Vietnamese children, FCVN members, and World Airways planes. This series also includes an audio CD "Waking Up American" with music by Jared Rehberg as well as six audiocassettes with recordings of meetings and other audio related to projects about children. The audiocassettes have not been reviewed by the Ford Library staff, but will be reviewed upon request.
