Summary Description

The William J. Baroody Files audiovisual series consists of photographs, transparencies, and audio recordings related to Baroody's work as the head of the Office of Public Liaison (OPL). The materials in the first portion of this series had been filed in the White House Central Files Oversized Attachments (OA) when they arrived at the Ford Library. During the processing of that collection staff identified them as part of Baroody's office files and transferred them to the Baroody Files. This portion contains portrait photographs of various Ford Administration Cabinet members and other government officials, as well as transparencies outlining the goals and functions of the OPL.

The second portion of this series consists of materials transferred from the Baroody Files textual series. It includes similar OPL transparencies and portrait photographs of Cabinet members and government officials, as well as photographs documenting the first year of the Ford Administration and meetings held by the OPL. It also contains audio recordings of a briefing Baroody gave for the Business-Government Relations Council; an appearance by Wayne Alderson and Samuel Piccolo on the Jim Robert Show on WHBC of Canton, Ohio; and a "HELP" consumer information phonograph record narrated by Virginia Knauer.
