Author Hugh Howard weaves together personal, presidential, and architectural histories to shed light on the way our chief executives lived.

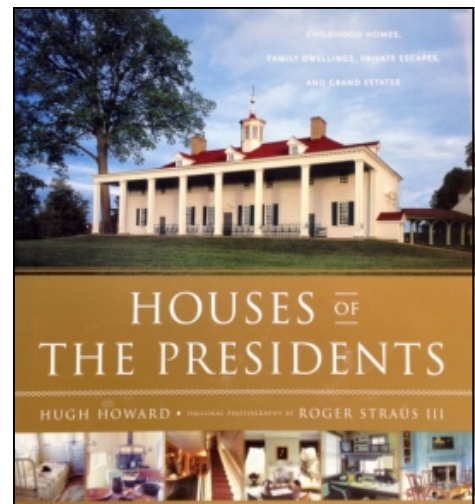
