Mr. Catto is Chairman of the Atlantic Council of the United States and the Council of Foreign Relations. He previously served as Director of the United States Information Agency (1991-93), U.S. Ambassador to Great Britain (1989-91) and to El Salvador (1971-73), Assistant Secretary of Defense (1981-83), U.S. Representative to the United Nations Offices in Geneva (1976-77), and the Chief of Protocol of the United States (1974-76). In 1999, the University of Texas Press published *Ambassadors at Sea: The High and Low Adventures of a Diplomat*, Mr. Catto's memoirs.
