Parking Guide for events at the Gerald R. Ford Presidential Library

There are 35 parking spots available in the parking lot adjacent to the Library. There is a sign (photo below) stating that visitors need to obtain a parking pass inside but as long as they are coming into the building for an event they are fine and don't need a pass (promise). These spots are available on a first come, first serve basis.




There is paid parking in the visitor parking lot at the VA hospital, across Fuller St. from the Library. This is about a 5-10 minute walk from the entrance to the Library. For that parking option follow this map:



Enter the VA hospital off of Fuller, onto Glazier Way and the visitor parking is on the left.

There is also paid parking within the Blue lot across Beal Ave. from the Library. It is about a 3-5 minute walk from the entrance to the Library. For that parking option follow this map:



Guests should go to exactly where the arrow is pointing, the red part of the NC16 lot. They can pull into the parking lot off of Beal Ave. and go through the Blue Lot parking area to the spots west of the kiosk. They can also access the lot off of Fuller Rd. (the entrance into the parking lot is the one before you get to Beal Ave) and the paid visitor parking spots are on the left.

Part of this lot is for Blue Lot parking pass holders only but if you see a sign like this you are good to pay and park there:



However, you CANNOT pay at the kiosk. If you don't have a coupon code from a department in the building adjacent to the parking lot it will not let you pay at the kiosk.

You MUST download the app or pay online. The app is "Passport Parking" and here is the logo:



It only takes a few minutes to set it up with payment information etc. and guests can delete it after the event if they choose.

OR, if they don't want to download the app they can scan the QR code seen on the sign on the kiosk that looks like this:



The QR code will take them to the Passport app but allows them to continue as a guest to pay without downloading the app.
