Brent, this is just a reminder concerning the request we received from Cardinal Krol in Philadelphia.

The Cardinal at that time asked him to encourage the Pope to attend the Eucharistic Conference, which is scheduled for Philadelphia, I believe, in early August of 1976. The President agreed to do it.
