Priority State Lists

Over the last several weeks I have received various memos outlining our target states. In each of these memos the list of priority states is somewhat different. I think it would be helpful if we could devise one common working list using the same definitions that would be accepted by all of the campaign divisions. Also, we could then hopefully get some agreement as to what the campaign implications of each category are in terms of all the different campaign efforts—scheduling of the President, the surrogates, advertising, organization, polling, budget allocation, etc.

As the campaign progresses we should re-evaluate each category, and if a state shifts from one group to another everyone would know how it affected their particular function.

As a framework from which to begin, I would suggest that the states be grouped into categories as shown on the attached sheet.
