Following our conversation September 18 concerning closer communication with Governor Reagan, Dean Burch and I recommend that you meet with Reagan about October 2 in San Francisco at a private dinner.

Dean is working with top level staff of Reagan on the dinner. We do not think a prior meeting here in Washington is desirable unless the Governor should happen to be in the area and request it. I understand that Reagan's primary reason for wanting to meet with you is to express his ideas on desirable governmental policies and programs.

Reagan has been invited to the Leone State Dinner, and although he has not yet responded, Tom Reed informs me that he will have to regret because of a previous commitment.

I am exploring possible appointments you might want to offer the Governor, such as membership on the Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board.
