As you know, Hugh O'Brian has been running the Hugh O'Brian Youth Foundation since its founding in 1958. Each year, with the assistance of the United States Jaycees and the National Association of Secondary School Principals, the Foundation holds "Leadership Seminars" in different subject areas. Last year, the Foundation held a "seminar on government" in Washington. This year (April 12-19), a'seminar on the economy" will be held in New York City.

Hugh may plan to invite you to attend the banquet (April 18) in connection with the New York seminar. If you do not accept, he may then seek your advice concerning a similar invitation to the Vice President.

Last fall, Mr. O'Brian began contacting us for assistance on a wide variety of problems, viz. getting other organizations to supplement the activities of the Jaycees in carrying out their role in connection with the program; getting several U. S. Senators to participate in the New York seminar; and seeking guidance on the general operation of his seminars in future years.

In an effort to assist Mr. O'Brian, we have met with him on several occasions as well as engage in many phone conversations.
