The White House filed this document in the Presidential Handwriting File with material from April 16, 1975.

The staff at the Ford Library discovered that this document is the second page of a memoranda from Warren Rustand to Donald Rumsfeld (through James Conner) written on March 3, 1975 regarding "April Invitations to Major Media Forums." Page one of this memo is currently located in the files of Warren Rustand.

Wednesday, April 16

American Society of Newspaper Editors (ASNE) meeting in Washington. Ron Nessen recommends that the President address this group. Jerry Warren has suggested that the President additionally host a White House reception for the editors. The President's schedule as we know it now is already very full (two dinners in the city, a day and a half trip out of town and a State visit.) For this reason we recommend that the President either address the convention at a local hotel or host a reception following a day of briefings for the editors arranged by Jerry Warren.
