MEMORANDUM FOR: THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Nomination of Reverend Thaddeus A. Garrett, Jr.
to the Consumer Product Safety Commission

1. It now appears the Senate will not act before adjournment on your nomination of Thadd Garrett to the Consumer Product Safety Commission (which was announced on July 22, 1976). The Senate Commerce Consumer Subcommittee held initial hearings on September 13.

2. Between adjournment and the new Congress, you can give Thadd a recess appointment, enabling him to serve for up to six months without Senate confirmation.

3. I recommend that you make this recess appointment in addition to others you may be considering.
