Last Friday we made the final payment on the \$2000 loan which you arranged for ACCL at Midland National Bank.

The loan was most helpful and we are very appreciative of your assistance in obtaining it.

On March 15 ACCL participated in a legislative news conference in Washington and on March 21 we testified before a House Judiciary subcommittee on a bill to prohibit black market baby selling.
