The proposed amendments would provide for the continuation of vocational education activities under the present authorities of the Vocational Education Act as well as the necessary positions to administer these activities under the Office of Education's Salaries and Expenses appropriation. The additional appropriations requested herein will continue the Federal and State efforts aimed at answering the need and demand for vocational education programs.

The Amendment of \$536,637,000 plus a permanent appropriation of \$7,161,000 would provide a total of \$543,798,000 for vocational education programs in fiscal year 1975.
