Developed by Professor Kano in 1882, it was designed to combine the best aspects of physical education, self-defense, and athletics in a study of throws and holds.

Kendo: Of the 20 participants, some will be international award-winning stars. Kendo, or Japanese fencing, began in the 18th century as a means for the military to practice swordsmanship. After the arrival of Commodore Perry, it was made compulsory in all educational institutions as a vehicle for moral development in the nation's youth. In a match, 2 contestants face each other in padded armor with swords made of split bamboo.

Naginata (Halberd): The naginata is one of the oldest weapons in Japan. Its principle of circular movement enables the user to keep someone at bay with a minimum of energy. The naginata has, historically, been one of the primary weapons for Japanese women of the military class and, today, is a popular form of physical education for girls. It is considered a splendid method of teaching respect for traditional etiquette and spiritual growth.

Gymnastics: Japan's top medalists will perform on the steel bar, flying rings, parallel bars, uneven parallel bars (female), and floor exercises.

Volleyball: Japan's world champion team will provide an exhibition match.

Guest attendance will include Japanese of many of the nation's sports federations, as well as residents of the American community.
