The President today accepted with regret the resignation of John D.J. Moore, of Short Hills, New Jersey, as Ambassador to the Republic of Ireland, effective June 30, 1975. He was appointed on April 19, 1969.

Prior to his appointment, Ambassador Moore was Vice President of W.R. Grace and Company, dealing with international and economic problems with the Republic of Ireland for almost twenty years.

Ambassador Moore received his A.B. degree in 1932 and his LL.B. degree in 1935 from Yale University.
