The President today announced his intention to nominate Stanley W. Legro, of Puerto del Sol, Rancho Santa Fe, California, to be an Assistant Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency. He will be responsible for the area of Enforcement. He will succeed Alan G. Kirk, II, who resigned effective January 31, 1975.

Mr. Legro was a founding partner in the firm of Legro and Rentto of San Diego, California serving since 1971. He was with the firm of Walsh and Gibson as a partner from 1967 to 1971. From 1966 to 1967 he was with the firm of Tuttle & Taylor.

Mr. Legro was born on July 3, 1936 in Muskogee, Oklahoma, received his B.S. degree with distinction from the United States Naval Academy in 1959. He served in the United States Marine Corps from 1959 until 1963. He received his J.D. degree cum laude from Harvard Law School in 1966.

Mr. Legro is married to the former Marcia Louise West and they have two children.
