NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of John Nicholas Brown, of Providence, Rhode Island, as a member of the National Armed Forces Museum Advisory Board of the Smithsonian for a term expiring April 9, 1980. This is a reappointment. He was appointed in 1962 and reappointed in 1968.

Mr. Brown is currently serving as President of the Counting House Corporation in Providence, Rhode Island.

The Board consists of two ex-officio members, the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of the Smithsonian Institution, and nine members appointed by the President. Of these nine members, three shall be from persons recommended by the Secretary of Defense, two shall be recommended by the Regents of the Smithsonian Institution, and of the other remaining four members, at least two shall be from civilian life.
