Pool Report of President Ford's trip from Cleveland to Washington:

He emerged from the hotel im Cleveland, waved to a small crowd and immediately entered the limousine. The ride to the airport was uneventful.

About 20 minutes before the arrival in Washington, he came back -- with Nessen and Dick Cheney -- to talk with reporters.

The President XX had a drink in hand, his collar was loose office and he carried his pipe in his hand.

Asked about an LA TEXEX Times story to the effect that he is considering the appointment of a crar for the intelligence community, he declined to MEKE enswer.

XX Did he know the tire blew on the way into Cleveland? "No, all I saw were things dropping down."

He was asked about rumors that he will officially announce next Tue
that he will run for a full term. MEXIXINEXXXXX "Well, next week
could be important," he said and then laughed. He was asked
about the format for the XXXXXX announcement. "The format for
XXXX what? You don't want to XX pre-empt any good story," he said.

He said his day in Ohio was "constructive, I thought it was constructive IK both philosophically as well as politically. We reaffirmed a good many ties with people in a broad spectrum on management, labor and professional and otherwise."

The pollution alert in Cincinnati "emphasized the need to get good affirmative KXXXXXX action." At his appearances, he said "there was a minimum of dissent or objections."

About his photo session in the pool on Saturday, he said:
"I've been practicing. I've been learning to MXXXXXX swim. XXXX
