QUESTION: Any thoughts on the Court ruling this morning on the Constitutionality of your oil tariff?

THE PRESIDENT: We are analyzing, of course, the decision by the Circuit Court of Appeals, and I will not know until later this afternoon what the Department of Justice and what my White House Counsel will recommend, but sometime this afternoon, I can give you a decision.

QUESTION: Was there a thought of taking that off anyway when decontrols lapsed?

THE PRESIDENT: That, of course, is an option that exists, and I have indicated on several occasions that we had a number of Administrative options, and that is in the group that we will have to look at if and when we decontrol, which we probably will.

QUESTION: Have a nice game, Mr. President.
