## President's Schedule

The President came to the Oval Office at 7:40 a.m. this morning. He met with members of his staff during the morning.

At 11:00 a.m., there will be a Cabinet meeting. Among the topics to be discussed will be the grain situation, a report on school openings, energy and economic matters.

At 2:00 p.m., the President will meet in the Cabinet Room with his Labor Management Committee to solicit the recommendations of the Committee on policies to encourage creation of more jobs.

The President will meet with the National Security Council at 3:30 p.m. in the Cabinet Room.

At 5:30 p.m., the President will greet the Executive Interchange Program Commissioners, Executives (Interchange VI), and the Commission Staff. These executives have been chosen to participate in the 60th Interchange Program. The President's Executive Interchange Program was established in 1969 to provide highly talented executives with an opportunity to gain experience by working temporarily in government or business for a one year period.

The President has signed an Executive Order delegating to the Secretary of Commerce functions relating to the orders for provision of chemicals or substances necessary for treatment of water.
