NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate John F. Grady of Waukegan, Illinois, to be United States District Judge for the Northern District of Illinois. He will succeed Edwin A. Robson, who resigned effective April 16, 1975. Mr. Grady is engaged in the practice of law in Waukegan. (A biographical sketch is attached).

The President today announced his intention to nominate Blair A. Griffith of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania to be United States Attorney for the Western District of Pennsylvania for a term of four years. He succeeds Richard L. Thornburgh, who assumed his duties as Assistant Attorney General on July 7, 1975. Mr. Griffith was Assistant United States Attorney for the Western District of Pennsylvania and has been serving as United States Attorney, appointed by the Court, since July. (A biographical sketch is attached.)

The President today announced his intention to nominate Arthur J. Wilson Jr., of East St. Louis, Illinois to be United States Marshal for the Eastern District of Illinois for a term of four years. He succeeds Harlan R. Hosch, who resigned effective December 29, 1974. Mr. Wilson was a Witness Security Specialist for the Eastern District of Virginia from 1973 to 1975 and, this year, was appointed by the Court to serve as United States Marshal for the Eastern District of Illinois.
