JUNE 20, 1976

IN THE ROSE GARDEN, BEFORE DEPARTING FOR BURNING TREE, THE
PRESIDENT SAID: "THE EVACUATION WAS A COMPLETE SUCCESS. EMBERANCEMENT
MY CONGRATULATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, THE DEPARTMENT
OF STATE, AND ALL OTHER AGENCIES INVOLVED. THE EVACUATION WAS
WELL-PLANNED AND WELL-EXECUTED. I AM GRATEFUL FOR THE COOPERATION
OF OTHER STATES AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS THAT COOPERATED TO RESTRAIN
ANY VIOLENCE OR TO KEEP THE AREA SECURE WHILE THE EVACUATION WENT
ON. THE UNITED STATES WILL CONTINUE ITS ROLE OF PEACEMAKER IN
LEBANON. WE WILL CONTINUE OUR ROLE AS A PARTY TO TRY AND ACHIEVE
THE LONG SOUGHT PEACE AND SECURITY IN THE MIDDLE EAST."

QUESTION: WOULD YOU MAKE CLEAR THE ROLE OF THE PLO IN THE EVACUATION EFFORT?

"THE PLO AND ALL OTHER PARTIES IN THE LEBANON AREA COOPERATED COMPLETELY IN MAKING IT POSSIBLE FOR US TO EVACUATE THE AMERICANS AND THE OTHER NATIONALS WITHOUT ANY INCIDENT WHATSOFFER."

TRIP TO BURNING TREE WAS UNEVENTFUL. THE OFF TIME WAS THE 2:18 p.m. PRESIDENT PLAYED WITH MEL LAIRD, TOM KLEPPE, AND BURNING TREE PRESIDENT ED PARKINSON.
