POOL REPORT NO. 2 - ARRIVAL IN SAN JUAN

There were four helicopters ferrying press, Secret Service and support personnel, as well as the President, into the resort complex. The helicopter landing area for the President's arrival and for all subsequent arrivals is on a golfing fairway about 150 yeards from the U.S. villa.

Puerto Rican police and EPS are providing joint security and are very much in evidence all over the resort. Security personnel even had German Shepherds on the fairway sniffing around the sand traps prior to the President's arrival and police are posted all around the villas that the participating nations will be using.

The President, on arrival, briefly paused at a short receiving line of resort executives then proceded directly with the Puerto Rican Governor to the U.S. villa. Each of the rooms in the villa overlooks the ocean. The President and the Puerto Rican Governor went around behind the U.S. villa and sat out on the lawn just behind the room in which the President will be staying. With the ocean as the background, the two sat down for a brief discussion but none of it could be heard.
