British Prime Minister James Callaghan, Foreign Minister Anthony Crossland, and Chancellor of the Exchequer Denis Healey arrived by helicopter at 7 p.m. at the helipad. They were greeted by President Ford, Kissinger, Simon and Scowcroft. As in all earlier arrivals, private greetings only were exchanged. Callaghan in a moment of levity, fingered the lapel of Kissinger's cream-colored ultrasuede sports jacket and drew a laugh from the officials.

FYI: Nessen announced that the Canadian party will arrive tomorrow (Sunday) at 2:15 p.m. in San Juan and 2:45 p.m. in Dorado. The French party will arrive at Dorado at 1 p.m. tomorrow as currently scheduled. Final note--Nessen says he will try to provide advance partial text of Ford's opening remarks to the conference before the 4 p.m. meeting convenes. He is planning to brief Sunday between 8 and 9 p.m. on the day's activities.

President's church plans for Sunday are still uncertain at the time, but the pool will be in place in time should the President decide to go.
