POOL REPORT ON RIDE TO O'HARE

President's motorcade got tied up in traffic on the way from Arlington Park Hilton to the airport on Interstate 194. In the midst of moderate snow, several cars darted in and out of the motorcade, and the President was slowed to speed of about 25 miles an hour. At a couple of points, the motorcade was forced to ride the shoulder. He arrived about 10 minutes late at the airport. At several points through the ride, the President used the talking car to say hello to motorists. At the airport, he also said hello to small groups of workers standing along the roadway. While there was traffic on several portions of the motorcade route to the airport, the police blocked off the intersection, causing some traffic tieups as long as a quarter of a mile.
