The exact quote, courtesy of Fran Lewine, was "Carter gives you peanuts; Vail Custom Jewelers gives you diamonds?"

Someone mentioned that to the President, and the President, referring to the lady who apparently ran the shop, the President said, "She told me about that and I stayed well away from it."

Then after he left the Alaskan Shop, he walked over to Pepi's with Pepi and Sheika, and they went inside and had a cup of coffee. They were in there for about 20 minutes. He came outside about 20 minutes after 3:00 and walked down the main drag of Vail up to his house.
