DECEMBER 28, 1976

President Ford and entourage arrived at the foot of chairlift 6 at 11:00 a.m. He thanked the press for "that very nice book" as he passed the pool. Vhen a reporter said that there was some confusion about what he is going to do about a general amnesty the President said: "There is no confusion. I said that at her request I will look at it and that is what I am going to do." Vhen pressed for clarification, Mr. Ford repeated his statement of yesterday that "the words speak for themselves." Vith that, the President donned his skis and was swept by the lift up the icy slopes of Golden Peak.
